Today is Tuesday, July 8, 2025, and the time being 5:30 pm. The meeting of the Greensburg Board of Works has been called to order.

Scott Hadler from St. Mary's Church requested road closures for the annual On Eagles Wings 5k event. Request from 8-10 am, also police officer at intersection of Millhousen Road and 421. Motion to approve closures as presented made by Robin Meyer, seconded by Jamie Cain. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Police Chief Mike McNealy presented the retirement of Investigator R. Jarrod McCalvin. Officer McCalvin has accepted a full time position as a school resource officer for Greensburg Community Schools. He will continue to serve as a reserve police officer. Along with a certificate of retirement, he also received his duty pistol.

Fire Chief Nate Stoermer presented a promotion of a firefighter. Lieutenant Jarrod Prentice is promoted to Captain. Chief asked that his promotion and pay increase be retroactive to June 11. Motion to approve the promotion and approve retroactive pay made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Lauren Barnhorst. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Chief Stoermer requested the purchase of a rescue apparatus. The current truck from 2004 that has served as the city/county rescue truck. There are several issues with the current one and many reasons to replace it. Chief proposed a Rosenbauer 24-foot box, vs the 18-foot standard. Rosenbauer is estimating a 2027 delivery. No payment is due until that time. Motion to approve the purchase made by Glenn Tebbe, seconded by Robin Meyer. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Chief Stoermer presented a contract for engineering services. The services would be to investigate the possibility of raising the roof on Station 2 to house an aerial truck. This contract would be a feasibility study only. After the study, then there will be further discussion on what the next steps could be, if any. Motion to approve the contract for engineering services with Strand Associates made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Glenn Tebbe. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Director of Public Projects Zach Wirrig gave updates on city projects. Washington Street project is moving along, with the intersection of Franklin and Washington being closed Monday, July 14. The project is still on schedule. Rebekah Park Trail ribbon cutting is July 16. There will be an information session for the Park Road project on August 6 for the public.

Mayor Joshua Marsh presented the Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation (OOR) Grant contract. There are currently 10 completed and approved applications. Inspections will start next week, then the projects will be sent out to bid. The contract is between the City, Office of Community and Rural Affairs (OCRA), and Administrative Resources Associates (ARa), who is doing most of the work. Motion to approve the contract made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Lauren Barnhorst. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Chief McNealy and Mayor Marsh did the official swearing in of Officer John Amis.

Motion to approve claims as presented made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Robin Meyer. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.
