Pledge of Allegiance

Today is Wednesday, July 8, 2026, and the time being 5:30 pm. The meeting of the Greensburg Board of Works has been called to order.

Minutes from the June 9 meeting were approved as presented.

New Business

Melissa Brown, Caleb Brown 5k and Fun Run, requested supervision for intersections for the fun run on the Saturday of the Fall Festival, September 21. Motion to approve the supervision as presented made by Robin Meyer, seconded by Jamie Cain. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passed.

Wastewater Superintendent Joe Cain requested approval for a contract with Strand Engineering. This would help with a requirement from IDEM that should've been met a couple of years ago. This is an extension of the on-call contract the City has had with Strand since 2021. Motion to approve the contract as presented made by Glenn Tebbe, seconded by Lauren Barnhorst. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passed.

Cain also presented a change order with Bainbridge Consulting on their work on the VLR. This was an unforeseen issue. Cain stated that it will be more cost effective for the issue to be handled now with Bainbridge Consulting already at the facility working on site. Motion to approve the change order as presented made by Glenn Tebbe, seconded by Robin Meyer. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passed.

Street Commissioner Mark Klosterkemper presented a request for a tandem truck replacement. Due to unforeseen circumstances with a previous company, he had to go "back to the drawing board" for another truck option. The request is to approve the proposal of \$79,900 for each of the two trucks, and the cabin chassis for \$149,000. The funds to be used for purchase will be the leftover funds from the building of the new street department building. This will allow Klosterkemper to purchase the trucks while they're still in stock. Motion to approve the purchase of the trucks and chassis not to exceed the amount currently left in

2022B bond proceeds made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Glenn Tebbe. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passed.

Klosterkemper updated the Board on issues with salt supplies in this section of the state for the next winter season. No decisions were made, for information only.

Klosterkemper also gave an update on the construction on 421. They are looking at an opening date of July 21 for the bridge in City limits, which is ahead of schedule.

Jamie Cain also asked about the use of 421 as a non-official detour. The state turned it down initially, and the City and County went in together to try and overturn that decision. No further information has been sent.

Director of Public Projects Zach Wirrig requested approval on the purchase of a trash and recycling bin for the downtown area. The amount for this is \$12,949.55. Motion to approve the purchase as presented made by Lauren Barnhorst, seconded by Glenn Tebbe. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passed.

Clerk Treasurer Amy Borns presented a Conflict-of-Interest form with another City employee, as required by the State Board of Accounts. Motion to approve the form made by Glenn Tebbe, seconded by Jamie Cain. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passed.

After additional discussion on the specifics of the form, there was a suggestion that the information on one of the lines be amended to \$3,500 plus in-kind support from the City. Motion to amend the conflict-of-interest form to read "\$3,500 plus in-kind support" made by Glenn Tebbe, seconded by Jamie Cain. Voice vote, all ayes no nays, Robin Meyer abstained. Motion passed.

Borns presented a three-year renewal contract with Granicus for the City's website. Borns has reached out to the company to see if there is an option for a one-year extension. This gives the new communication director time to learn the site before committing it to a full three years. Motion to table website contract Glenn Tebbe, seconded by Jamie Cain. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passed.

Motion to approve the claims as presented made by Robin Meyer, seconded by Jamie Cain. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passed.

Adjourn
