Fire Chief Nathan Stoermer gave an update on the Rosenbauer 22' walk around heavy rescue truck, which was approved and ordered in 2023. Currently, delivery is expected in 2027. Payment will be expected upon delivery. This will be worked into the 2027 budget and has been accounted for in planning for that year.

Chief Stoermer also invited all in attendance to National Night Out, which will take place on August 14 from 5-8 pm at North Park. Food will be served, and there will be a live demonstration between law enforcement, fire, and EMS.

Director of Public Projects Zach Wirrig presented updates of ongoing projects.

Mayor Marsh discussed the recent budget workshop, noting that the second one scheduled for August 26<sup>th</sup> is no longer necessary. An updated version of the budget has been sent out to all Council members. Jamie Cain

announced that the discussion of bi-weekly pay has been tabled. The main reason for the discussion was how to get through the 53-week pay period, but it feels that it can be handled with the current budget.

Mayor Marsh reminded all that the September meeting has been moved up to September 3.

Marsh also reminded all that the November meeting will be Wednesday November 12 due to Veteran's Day falling on the normally scheduled Tuesday.

Council members gave updates on their respective boards and councils.

Water Department Superintendent Aaron Schwendenmann gave an update on the Water Department.
