### Public Hearing

Mayor Marsh asked if there is anyone present who would like to speak on the budget. Hearing and seeing no one, Mayor called for a motion to close the meeting.

Erin Thomas of Lifetime Resources (Catch-A-Ride) gave an annual report of the organization. Thomas also came with a request for support of \$10,000, which is the same amount as this past year.

Fire Chief Nathan Stoermer gave an update to the Council on an apparatus purchase approved by the Board of Works earlier in the evening. Stoermer only gave an update, no action item required by the Council.

Mayor Marsh presented Ordinance 2025-09 2026 Greensburg City Budget for first reading. Motion to approve Ordinance 2025-09 Greensburg City Budget on first reading made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood. Voice vote, 5 ayes, 1 nay (5-1). Motion passes.

Mayor Marsh presented Ordinance 2025-010 2026 Elected Officials Salary Ordinance for first reading. Motion to approve Ordinance 2025-10 Elected Officials Salary Ordinance on first reading made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood. Voice vote, 5 ayes, 1 nay (5-1). Motion passes.

Mayor Marsh presented Ordinance 2025-12 2026 Greensburg City Salary Ordinance for first reading. Motion to approve Ordinance 2025-12 2026 Greensburg City Salary Ordinance on first reading made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Mayor Marsh presented Ordinance 2025-13 2026 Greensburg Utilities Salary Ordinance for first reading. Motion to approve Ordinance 2025-13 2026 Greensburg Utilities Salary Ordinance on first reading made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Clerk Treasurer Amy Borns presented Ordinance 2025-14 Additional Appropriations. There are two lines for the additional. The first line is for the airport, which transferred money from one fund to another at the beginning of the year with the plan of putting that money toward the Jackson County Bank loan. The other line is for overtime for the police and fire. There were several payouts for retirements in both departments that need to be covered with the additional appropriation. Motion to approve Ordinance 2025-14 Additional Appropriations on first reading made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood. Voice vote, all ayes no nays.

Borns presented Resolution 2025-14 Transfer Resolution for funds that need to be moved from different funds into the Park Road fund as planned on each year during budget season. Motion to approve Resolution 2025-14 made by Vietta McKenzie, seconded by Jamie Cain. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Borns presented Resolution 2025-15 that will allow the City to use Square as a platform to accept payments online for certain fees or services. Motion to approve Resolution 2025-15 made by Daryl Tressler, seconded by Rodney King. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Director of Public Projects Zach Wirrig presented an update on current city projects. Milling and paving for the downtown square should be finished by this weekend. O'Mara will continue to finish work on Broadway, 1<sup>st</sup> Street, and a few other areas in the following weeks.

Mayor Joshua Marsh requested an appointment to the Lilly Scholarship Committee. Jamie Cain nominated Mark Carman, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

The Council voted on the Trick or Treat hours for October 31, 2025. Motion to approve 5-8 PM on October 31, 2025, made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Mark Carman. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Reminder that there is a special meeting on Tuesday, September 16, at 5:30 PM, for the Greensburg Community Schools' 2026 budget.

Council members gave updates on their respective boards and councils.
