Brendan Bridges, Police Chief presented Greensburg Police Department Wellness Policy. Nate Stoermer, Fire Chief presented Greensburg Fire Department Wellness Policy at the podium along with Chief Bridges.

Discussion followed regarding changes from original presentation. Be it noted that Chief Bridges and Chief Stoermer are establishing the policy and standards now in 2020, upon approval from the City Council, the 2022 budget would need to include an additional line item.
