New business:

1-Sarah submitted request for James Mills of Summit Microsystems Inc. 1932 N. Hessler Blvd., Greensburg, In. for permanent special exception of temporary request of nearly one year ago on having his computer business out of his home. No complaints have been noted.

Phil moved and Alan seconded to approve. It passed 3-0.

2-Justin Speer submitted request for variance for building a pole barn structure at 903 E. Hendricks, Greensburg for RV storage. Square footage would be 1728 vs. 720 per ordinance. Height would be 16 feet. Letters were sent to adjoining property owners of which Rita Hellmich responded that she was not in favor of this request. Willie Wilson from the neighborhood voiced resistance as the size of the building would cheapen property values of the neighborhood. No others responded.

3-Brian Spencer 518 Lisa Lane, Greensburg, requested a variance to approve a carport already put up but without variance approval. He acknowledged he was remiss in his request. Sarah learned of the construction via questions from concerned neighbors.

Phil moved and Alan seconded to approve. It was denied 3-0. Mr. Spencer was directed to remove the carport.
