 - o Broadway & 10th Street Project Update
 - Darren reported that he is working on getting the permits submitted; the next step is advertising, and he will try to do that later this month. There have been a few changes that Aaron Schwendenmann and his group have made on the North end by Smith Rd; they incorporated a couple sidewalks in the plans as well.  - o Hach Service Agreement
 - Aaron said nothing has changed with the agreement. Hach is a third-party business that tests all the lab equipment; all tests are done onsite. Frank Massey made a motion to approve the quote of \$34,245.00; Tony Higginbotham seconded the motion, voice vote all ayes and motion was carried.
 - o MacAllister Shoring Equipment Purchase
 - This equipment provides safer leak repairs by keeping the trenches from caving in, it can be used by one employee in the back of a truck vs. a trailer. Aaron and a few of his employees have had training on the equipment. Frank Massey made a motion to approve the quote for \$7098.31; Scott Mangels seconded the motion, voice vote all ayes and motion was carried.






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
