 - o Broadway & 10th Street Update
 - Darren presented the board with the 50% drawings, noting they will change before the end. He is planning a walkthrough of the entire route in a couple weeks as it is a busy corridor. The next drawings will be at 90%, which will have a profile view in vertical sections of other utilities and obstacles in the area.
- Zach Wirrig
 - o Projects Update –
 - Main Street – reviewed their plans and marked up all the service lines they had questions with on the east and west sides of Main Street.
 - West Main Street – received their preliminary plans for the jack and bore under the railroad, waiting to hear from the railroad.
 - Park Road – HWC finalized their coordination with USI for the final location of the water line. Pending the latest information from SRF funding, we are moving in the direction of the waterline work falling into the Park Road Project and will be funded outside of SRF funding.
- Aaron Schwendenmann
 - o Tractor Purchase
 - Aaron presented a Sourcewell Quote (government cooperative purchasing) for a Bobcat CT2040 Compact Tractor HST in the amount of \$30,204.16. This cost is to be split with the Street Department, \$15,102.08 each. Frank Massey made motion to approve \$15,102.08, Scott Mangels seconded the motion, voice vote all ayes and motion carried.

Public Comment

- City Attorney Chris Stephen presented Mr. Todd Cobbs, 1436 W. Daniel Dr., Greensburg, Indiana, the topic reference is "New Information on Fluoridation".
 - o Mr. Cobbs addressed the board with his concerns on fluoridation and referenced a court case in the United States District Court Northern District of California, September 24, 2024, Case No 17-cv-02162-EMC, Food & Water Watch, Inc., et al. v. United States Environmental Protection Agency, et al., which is online. Mr. Cobbs feels we are getting too much fluoride. He noted that Connersville just voted to continue fluoridation with no one asking what fluoride is. Florida and Utah, Utah being the first, voted not to fluoridate. Robert Kennedy, US Health Secretary, plans to tell the CDC (Centers on Disease Control and Prevention) to stop recommending fluoride in drinking water. Mr. Cobbs referenced a report, NTP Monograph: State of the Science Concerning Fluoride Exposure and Neurodevelopment and Cognition: A Systematic Review. Mr. Cobbs thanked the board for their time; the board in turn thanked him for his concerns and information.




