- July 2, 2024, minutes were approved as presented.




- **SRF Projects Approval – Rick Denney** discussed the following projects:
 1. N Broadway Street water line around to 10th Street (4th to 10th, Broadway to Lincoln and across the By-pass)
 2. INDOT Main Street Project starts in 2027, need to replace 200 to 300 hundred feet under the railroad tracks on West Main Street
 3. Rehab South Water Tower
 4. West Main Street Loop (extend to Park Road at Ryle Addition)
 5. Large Meters
 Darren will compile the PER for SRF funding and asked for Board approval. Frank Massey made motion to approve, Tony Higginbotham seconded, all ayes and motion carried.
- **Dam Inspection - Rick Denney** presented a proposal from Christopher B Burke Engineering to inspect the dam (Upland Reservoir) which is inspected every two years, in the amount of a fixed fee of \$5,000.00. Ryan Maddux made motion to accept the proposal, Scott Mangels seconded, all ayes and motion carried.
- **Darren Burkert - HNTB** – Darren Burkert presented and discussed a proposal to update the PER for the SRF funded projects; lump sum amount being \$64,000.00. Frank Massey made motion to approve, Ryan Maddux seconded, all ayes and motion carried.
- **July MRO – Rick Denney** included the July MRO in the board’s packet and noted there was no issues.
- **Mayor’s Issues** – Mayor Marsh was present but had no issues.
