- **Employee Recognition** – Rick Denney introduced Chris Johnson, his Foreman, and explained his role with the Water Works. Chris has been employed with the City since March 2000.
- **Rate Study** – Katelyn Shafer & Brooke Shaley, from Reedy Financial Group P.C., presented the Greensburg Municipal Water Works rate study report, recommending a 12.44% increase, which includes a 3% inflationary increase, being phased over 3 years. **Tony made motion to recommend the increase to Council for approval, Brian seconded, voice vote all ayes and motion carried.**
- **HNTB Update** – Darren Burkhardt gave an update on the New Surface Water Plant Field Operations Building stating the move-in date could be late October, early November, and noted all is still running on schedule.
- **MRO** – Rick Denney included his August MRO (monthly operations report) in the boards packet. The Board had no questions.
- **Rick Denney** gave an update on activated carbon, and water tower inspections.
