- Darren Burkhart South Water Tower Darren presented the final version of their study, discussed the variable fire flow of the alternate sites as well as the impact of construction at the sites. Further discussion was rehabbing the current tank as being the most cost effective but recommends replacing it with a tank that will last 70 plus years. He stated looping the system with a 12" line and placing it in an anticipated growth area, would be best. The timetable for the project would be 12-18 months, during construction season. Mayor Marsh mentioned our rate study is due to start next year and we can work this into the rate study. The Board thanked Darren and took this under advisement.
- Upland Reservoir IEAP Approval Rick Denney presented the IEAP (Incident and Emergency Action Plan) from Chrisopher B Burke Engineering, LLC, for Upland Reservoir.
