- Darren Burkhart
 - o Broadway & 10th Street Update
 - Darren reported he shared the 90% drawings with Water Superintendent Aaron Schwendenmann and his staff and will forward them to the board, along with a cost estimate. He noted they need to work through details on side street tie-ins, pavement repair, and work with INDOT for a permit to cross Highway 3. He hopes to have the 100% drawings next month, along with a schedule. He anticipates a bid opening late this year or early next year. Darren noted they had a walkthrough which was very helpful.
- Zach Wirrig
 - o Projects Update –
 - Main Street – have the 90% plans from Michael Baker along with cost estimates. Do not have the cost estimate on the jack and bore under the railroad tracks. On track to bid next July.
 - Park Road – Our part is on hold right now. Sewer and Water are locked in where we need to be. The project is moving along the way it should be.
 - Financially – Mainstreet, minus the bores through INDOT. We had to make a commitment to fund Park Road to get it pushed along through our rates.
- Aaron Schwendenmann
 - o Hydro Excavator
 - Aaron Schwendenmann presented a memo expressing the need for a Hydro Vac Truck Purchase along with Vehicle Quote, Q14734, for the purchase of the Hydro Vac Truck from Brown Equipment Company, which is a Sourcewell Quote. Aaron stated they looked at four different companies. Water employees Chris Martin and Greg Kelso expressed their opinions and approval for this company as well. Frank Massey made motion to approve the purchase of \$599,990.00, Tony Higginbotham seconded the motion, voice vote all ayes and motion carried. Board President Patrick Kennedy commented on how well the project was written; it was clear, and thanked Aaron for that as well as thanked Mr. Kelso and Mr. Martin for coming.
