They have a concept plan for maintenance and traffic and plans to discuss the concept with stakeholders to review detours and lane closures; once that is complete, they will submit the permit for the State Road 3 crossing. The plan is to jack and bore and directional bore.

    - Aaron reported that the Vac Truck was delivered last Friday and was used to locate a water main today and said it went well. Aaron encouraged the board to stop by and see it; the board thanked him and his crew for acknowledging the need and for their presentation when requesting the purchase.
