- Darren Burkhart
 - o Broadway & 10th Street Update
 - Darren reported they are working on getting the 100% plan as well as the maintenance and traffic plan. Once they have them, they will submit applications to IDEM and get permits from INDOT. The plan is to bid the water and sewer projects together.
- Zach Wirrig
 - o INDOT Main St Reconstruction Agreements
 - Zach presented an agreement from INDOT for the Main Street Project noting there is no financial commitment, it is just allowing the work INDOT is doing to be in the contract; he is needing the contract approved and signed. City Attorney Chris Stephen reviewed the contract and had no issues. Tony Higginbotham made motion to approve the contract/signature, Frank Massey seconded, voice vote all ayes and motion carried.
- Aaron Schwendenmann
 - o Upland Flow Meter Replacement
 - Aaron reported they need to look at replacing the flow meter at Upland (Reservoir) as it is failing by reading a low number which is making the pumps work harder; staff have been adjusting the pumps manually as needed. Aaron has BL Anderson checking to see if the current meter can be rebuilt, which is highly unlikely. The quote presented is for a custom meter, which has a twelve-week lead time, cost being \$10,702.08, not to exceed an average of \$1,500.00. Frank Massey made motion to approve the quote, Scott Mangels seconded, voice vote all ayes and motion carried.
