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- 11:35–11:45**      **Drive to The Commons**  
Distance: 1 mile
- 11:45–12:45**      **Lunch at The Commons**  
Cuisine: choose from a food-court of options including Golden, Brown & Delicious, Automatic Tacos, The Bake Room, Methodical Coffee, and Community Tap. Features: Set amidst Greenville’s new 60-acre Unity Park, you can eat your lunch in view of the site of Greenville’s old Meadowbrook Park where Tommy Lasorda, Mickey Mantle, Joe Jackson, Ted Williams, and many other illustrious baseball greats have played.
- 12:45–1:00**      **Drive to the Shoeless Joe Jackson Museum & Library**  
Distance: 1.5 mile
- 1:00–2:00**      **Tour at the Shoeless Joe Jackson Museum & Library**  
Features: Come inside Shoeless Joe’s actual home that is now a museum that displays personal artifacts, period memorabilia, and educational and interactive displays that tell you all about the career and life of one of baseball’s greatest hitters.
- 2:00–3:00**      **Drive to the Village of West Greenville where Shoeless Joe lived, worked, and played baseball**  
Features: See the Brandon Mill (built in 1901, now loft apartments) where Joe worked, the streets he walked and lived on, and the actual baseball field where he got his career started. \*If there is time, drive to the Woodside mill baseball field where the original brick bleachers and dugouts (the only original baseball structure left in town) where many mill teams played...a real “field of dreams!”
- 3:00–4:00**      Early access into Fluor Field to watch batting practice and warm-ups
- 4:00–4:45**      **Behind the scenes ballpark tour and viewing of Shoeless Joe Jackson statue**
- 5:00–6:00**      **Buffet style dinner prepared by the ballpark Executive Chef and culinary team.**
- 7:00–9:30**      **Greenville Drive baseball game**  
Features: This facility won ballpark of the year when it opened and is a scaled-down version of Boston’s Fenway Park complete with a “green monster” wall and “Pesky’s Pole”
- 9:30**      **Drive back to Greenville**
