9:00-10:00 Breakfast, coffee, and a walk-through Unity Park

> Cuisine: Taste some of the best breakfast sandwiches, pastries, and coffee all in one location of a food-court including Golden, Brown & Delicious, The Bake Room, and Methodical Coffee at The Commons, a local's favorite. After breakfast, take a stroll around the 60-acre Unity Park.

10:00-10:15 **Drive to Christ Church Episcopal Church**

Distance: 1.5 Miles

10:15-11:00 **Tour of Christ Church Episcopal Church**

> Features: Come inside downtown Greenville's oldest church building from 1854 and see the beautiful wooden hammer-beamed ceiling, rare stained-glass windows including one made by

Tiffany Studios.

11:00-12:00 Walk from Christ Church to Main St. via E. North St. for shopping

> Features: Retail between College St. and Coffee St. features such destinations as a gem store, old-time general store, high end beach apparel, casual southern clothes, candle shop, world spices, fresh olive oils, and a toy store.

11:00-12:00 **Lunch at ONE Plaza**

> Cuisine: Choose from the variety of different cuisines offered at ONE Plaza: Thai (Basil), Mexican (Cantina 76), Southern (Tupelo Honey), and Coffee Shop (Methodical Coffee).

12:00-12:30 **Walk to Court Square**

> Grab some gourmet popcorn at Poppington's on the way, with a stop into the lobby and grand ballroom of Greenville's oldest hotel, the 1925 Westin Poinsett. The Visitor's Center at City Hall for city brochures and maps.

12:30-1:15 Walk to the Embassy Suites at RiverPlace and take the elevator to Up on the Roof

Order a cocktail, beer, wine, tea or soda and soak in the rooftop views of the Reedy River,

Riverwalk, downtown skyline, and the Blue Ridge Mountains.

1:15-2:00 Stroll down the Riverwalk and stop in to see some of the artists' studios at Art

Crossing

Take some photos inside the old Duke's mayonnaise factory before making your way to Liberty Bridge to overlook the centerpiece of Greenville-- the 40 ft. Reedy River waterfall. Features: river and streams, bird watching, mountain views, Carrick Creek Nature Center on site.

2:00-3:30 Drive from Falls Park to the Village of West Greenville and Poe West

Discover the city's art district with art studios, restaurants, shops, a brewery, and distillery.





3:30–5:00 Drive to Heritage Green

Features: Greenville County Library System, Greenville County Museum of Art, Greenville Theatre, Upcountry History Museum, The Children's Museum of the Upstate, and Sigal Music

Museum.

5:00–5:15 Drive to your dinner destination

5:00–6:30 Dinner at Soby's New South Cuisine

Cuisine: As one of Greenville's longest running and most iconic restaurants, Soby's offers a wide variety of southern favorites for one to choose from, all within the setting of Main Street's oldest building, an 1856 former dry goods store.
