8:15–8:45	Drive to Tandem Creperie from Greenville Distance: 10 miles
8:45–9:45	Breakfast at Tandem Creperie Features: Creative savory and sweet made-to-order crepes, waffles and flavored lattes, coffees, and teas.
10:00–11:00	Explore unique Travelers Rest retail spots like Carolina Honeybee Co, Retro Marketplace antiques, Silver Lily Boutique, Urban Hare, As the Page Turns Bookstore, and Homebody gift shop
11:00–11:20	Drive to Lake Robinson via Tigerville Rd, Jackson Grove Rd., and Milford Church Rd. Distance: 9.5 miles
11:20–11:40	Overlook of Lake Robinson and Blue Ridge Mountains at J. Verne Smith Park
11:40–12:00	Drive to Downtown Greer Distance: 9.5 miles
12:00-1:00	Lunch in Downtown Greer Cuisine: Choose from local favorites such as the Great Bay Oyster House, Barista Alley, Harvest Kitchen, and Thai Vegan.
2:15–3:15	Shopping in Downtown Greer Features: Explore Shoppes off Trade, The Hanger Boutique, Galleries at Brian Brigham, Smith & James, and Talloni and Sparkling Sisters Boutique. Don't forget to check out the shops at the century-old Greer Station train depot.
3:15–3:45	Drive to downtown Simpsonville via Hwy 14 Features: Drive through the new Hartness community on Society St. to see the charming new luxury planned community with its distinctive architecture, restaurants, shops, and hotel (forthcoming).
3:45–4:15	Ice cream snack at Ice Cream Station and explore local shops Cuisine: ice cream, mix-ins, sundaes, smoothies, malts, shakes, etc. Features: Set within a old brick train depot next to the rail line in the heart of downtown Simpsonville. Nearby shops include Three Generations Boutique (women's clothing), The Front Porch (home goods) and Cocobon Chocolatier.

4:35–5:15 Explore the beautiful scenery of Falls Park and the Liberty Bridge Features: Art galleries, shops, and historic buildings all along the Riverwalk.

5:30–6:45 Dinner at your choice of over 100 places to eat in the downtown area Cuisine: You can find just about anything to suit your tastes including favorites like Jianna, Rick Erwin's West End Grill, Hall's Chophouse, The Lazy Goat, Soby's New South Cuisine, and Nose Dive.
