



**BUS TOUR ITINERARY**

# **Rivers, Lakes, Bridges and Waterfalls**

*Accommodates 40–55 guests*

*Duration: 10 hours*





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- 10:00–11:00**      **Bus drops off at Reedy View Dr. and River St. for a stroll down the Riverwalk to Falls Park on the Reedy**  
Features: 26-acre Falls Park and Riverwalk with restaurants, shops, art studios, garden features, and the one-of-a-kind pedestrian Liberty Bridge overlooking the upper Reedy Falls. Witness an 1857 building from the Gower, Cox and Markley Carriage Co. and the original Duke Mayonnaise factory building (1923-58).
- 11:00–11:15**      **Walk down the Prisma Health Swamp Rabbit Trail System to Rock Quarry Garden**  
Distance: 0.8 miles  
Features: Along the path you'll walk past the lower Reedy Falls with adjacent ruins from Greenville's first downtown textile mill, the 1874 Sampson & Hall mill. You'll also pass the airplane memorial for Greenville pilot Rudy Anderson, the only American casualty of the Cuban Missile Crisis.
- 11:15–11:45**      **Visit to Rock Quarry Garden**  
Features: Manicured lawns, flowerbeds and a rock-lined stream fed by a 20-foot natural waterfall.
- 11:45–12:00**      **Bus picks up at Sherwood Forest Dr. and drive to Brick Street Café**  
Distance: 1 mile
- 12:00–1:30**      **Lunch at Brick Street Café**  
Cuisine: Scratch-made sandwiches, salads, soups, and pasta. The cakes (notably the sweet potato cake) are legendary.
- 1:30–2:00**      **Drive to Lake Robinson**  
Distance: 15 miles
- 2:00–2:45**      **Visit Lake Robinson**  
Features: Excellent views overlooking the 800-acre lake with Blue Ridge Mountains in the background.
- 2:45–3:10**      **Drive to Campbell's Covered Bridge**  
Distance: 10 miles
- 3:10–4:10**      **Visit Campbell's Covered Bridge over Beaverdam Creek**  
Features: Experience South Carolina's last remaining covered bridge which was built in 1909. The tranquil waters of Beaverdam Creek flow under the bridge and guests can explore the grounds on the bridge and in the water.



- 4:10–4:30**      **Drive to Poinsett Bridge over Calahan Branch Creek**  
Distance: 10 miles
- 4:30–5:00**      **Visit the historic Poinsett Bridge**  
Features: Built in 1820, the Poinsett Bridge is the oldest bridge in South Carolina. The gothic arch opening is a unique feature of this dry-laid natural stone bridge.
- 5:00–5:20**      **Drive to Restaurant 17 at Hotel Domestique**  
Distance: 6 miles
- 5:20–6:45**      **Arrive at Restaurant 17 for dinner**  
Cuisine: This chef-driven restaurant is led by Chef Hayden Schaak and serves elegantly presented farm-to-table entrees in a fine-dining setting with views of the Blue Ridge Mountains.
- 6:45**              **Drive back to Greenville**
