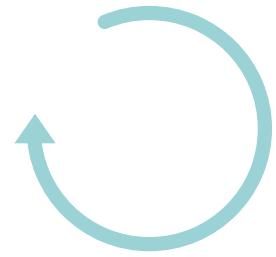

## SUNRIFT ADVENTURES

Sunrift is a well-known outdoors shop with gear for outdoor lovers including climbing, paddling, biking, hiking, rentals & expert advice.

## TANDEM CRÊPERIE & COFFEEHOUSE

Try their sweet and savory crêpes, waffles, homemade granola, handcrafted sodas, kombucha, fresh juice, and a variety of teas.

## TR MAKERS CO.

A hub for artisans and art lovers offering handcrafted goods, maker kits, and art activities. A great stop to check out with in Travelers Rest. (also called “TR”)

## SWAMP RABBIT BREWERY & TAPROOM

A family and pet-friendly brewery with outdoor seating, a variety of beers, small bites, & events.

## UPCOUNTRY PROVISIONS

Serves breakfast, lunch, and dinner with live music, a unique dining experience, and vegetarian, vegan, and gluten-free options.

## TRAILBLAZER PARK

This park is a performing arts and cultural center with green space, live music, movies, a nature-themed playground, and picnic shelters. This park also hosts the Travelers Rest Farmers Market.

## HISTORY MUSEUM OF TRAVELERS REST

Exhibits artifacts related to TR's history as a rest stop, located in a building with bricks from the old Travelers Rest High School.

Tip Box: The Travelers Rest Farmers Market is open every Saturday from May - September, 8:30 am - 12 pm, featuring over 70 vendors, live music, kids' activities, free yoga, & food trucks.

## FURMAN UNIVERSITY

Furman is private liberal arts university with a 1.5-mile lake loop, 13 miles of trails, a rose garden, Thoreau’s cabin replica, historic buildings, and a Japanese temple.

Tip Box: Stroll along Furman University's lake loop encircling a 40-acre, spring-fed lake, offering views of Paris Mountain. This scenic path is a highlight of the campus, featuring the iconic Furman Bell Tower.



## SWAMP RABBIT STATION @ BEREA

Unique pocket park halfway between Greenville and Travelers Rest, featuring an information kiosk, seating, a water refill station, a turnaround for handicap bikes, a vintage railcar that all kids love to see, and a mural of Berea's history.

## SWAMP RABBIT CAFÉ & GROCERY

Swamp Rabbit Café is a locally owned café, grocery store, and bakery offering a food hub, picnic space, and free stecca bread for first-time visitors. This is a true gem of Greenville and is extremely bike friendly.

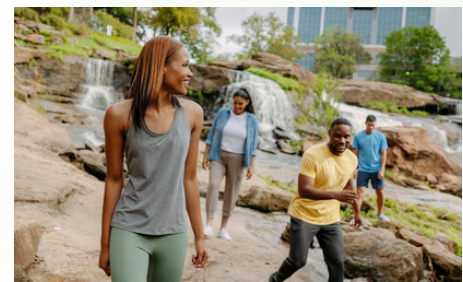


## UNITY PARK & THE COMMONS

This 60-acre park with basketball courts, state-of-the-art playgrounds, a splash pad, green spaces, picnic tables, a welcome center with restrooms, and event space is the perfect first stop on your tour. The Commons features an array of food options including Automatic Taco, The Bake Room, GB&D, Community Tap, Methodical Coffee, and more. Keep an eye out for more restaurants and businesses opening soon.

## FALLS PARK ON THE REEDY

This is Greenville’s most iconic and picturesque park with the Reedy River, beautiful waterfalls, & the 345-foot Liberty Bridge, which is designed to immerse you into the surrounding nature. Falls Park also features the Grand Bohemian Lodge with views of the falls, a luxurious spa, art collections, and outdoor dining at Between the Trees and Spirit & Bower.



## CLEVELAND PARK

Head to Greenville's largest park with nature trails, playgrounds, workout stations, picnic shelters, green spaces, the Greenville Zoo, sports facilities, Rock Quarry Garden, and the Vietnam Veterans Memorial. [Tip: You can sign up to feed the Giraffes at the Zoo!](#)

## FLYING RABBIT ADVENTURES

Visit this nature-based high-ropes adventure course with climbing, jumping, swinging, and ziplining.

### DOUBLE STAMP BREWERY

This 1990s-themed brewery with a variety of local craft beers on tap should definitely be your next stop!

### HOME TEAM BBQ

Family-friendly restaurant with a spacious screened-in porch, reclaimed wood decor, and a diverse menu.

## PLACES TO STOP AROUND GREENVILLE'S DOWNTOWN AIRPORT:

- [White Duck Taco Shop](#): Known for unique taco flavors like beef bulgogi and jerk chicken. Their most popular taco is their crispy pork belly taco with pickled watermelon rind and green onion aioli.
- [Elevation 966 Winery](#): A boutique urban and premier winery with exquisite wines and true craftsmanship.
- [Military History Center of the Carolinas](#): A non-profit center dedicated to honoring veterans and preserving military history.
- [Runway Park](#): Check out this park with an aviation-themed playground, swing set, picnic hangar, and a Cessna 310 display. You can watch planes take off and land and the best part... it's totally free. You can also eat at Runway Cafe.
- [Takeoff Mini Golf](#): Just what it sounds like! This is an aviation-themed mini golf course.
- [The Rad Rabbit](#): An 800-foot biking trail with rollers, tabletops, and berms, designed for all skill levels. Feeling adventurous? This is the stop for you!

## LEGACY PARK

This 20-acre park with rolling hills, water features, small clumps of trees, a man-made pond and two playgrounds was inspired by Frederick Law Olmstead's design for NYC's Central Park. This park is located in a residential area with nearby restaurants such as Takosushi & Stella's Southern Brasserie.
