Duration: 10 hours

- 9:00–9:15**      **Bus drives from downtown Greenville to Stax Original Restaurant**  
Distance: 4 miles
- 9:15–10:15**      **Breakfast at a 1950s era diner for a great comfort food breakfast**  
Cuisine: omelets, home fried potatoes, country ham, corn beef hash, benedicts, pancakes, waffles  
Features: the original soda fountain stools and counters diner layout will bring you back to when times were simpler and waitstaff know your name.
- 10:15–10:30**      **Drive to Mast General Store**  
Distance: 4 miles
- 10:30–12:00**      **Shopping at Mast General Store**  
Features: Housed in a nostalgic 19th century Meyers-Arnold department store building, Mast General is what travel journalist Charles Kuralt described, “Where should I send you to know the Soul of the South? I think I’ll send you to the Mast General Store.”
- 12:00–12:15**      **Drive to Duke’s Sandwich Shop**  
Distance: 4 miles
- 12:15–1:30**      **Lunch at Duke’s Sandwich Shop**  
Cuisine: Favorite sandwiches include pimento cheese, egg salad, chicken salad, ham & cheese, BLT, and more.  
Features: Mrs. Duke’s deliciously simple sandwiches propelled her fame in the 1917 era; drug stores and pharmacies embody a taste of home. The entrees here were part of the fabric of mill villages and southern communities and still delight folks today with their nostalgic flavors.
- 1:30–1:45**      **Drive to the Upcountry History Museum**  
Distance: 3 miles
- 1:45–3:00**      **Visit the Upcountry History Museum**  
Features: Displays, dioramas and interactive educational features will immerse you in what life was like in the Upstate’s pioneer times through its textile era and into the late 20th century.
- 3:00–3:15**      **Drive to Pickwick Pharmacy**  
Distance: 4 miles
- 3:15–4:15**      **Dessert/snack at the Pickwick Pharmacy**  
Cuisine: Shakes and malts, fresh-squeezed orangeade and lemonade, hotdogs, and chilidogs, 20 flavors of ice cream, and cherry and vanilla cokes.  
Features: Sit at an authentic 1949 soda fountain counter that has been serving Greenville for three generations.
