- 9:30–10:00**      **Leave downtown Greenville to Happy Cow Creamery**  
Distance: 20 miles
- 10:00–11:30**      **Tour Happy Cow Creamery**  
Details: This “Grass to Glass” tour will take you on a trolley ride to see the lush grazing paddocks followed by a visit to the milking parlor and a sampling of milk and ice cream. The bottling plant is the only one in the world located in a Harvestore silo.  
\*Tours must be reserved and are weather permitting.
- 11:30–11:45**      **Drive to Cityscape Winery**
- 11:45–12:45**      **Lunch and wine tasting at Cityscape Winery**  
Cuisine: Order from food menu or indulge in one of their hand-crafted charcuterie boards paired with a glass of wine.
- 12:45–1:15**      **Drive to Twin Creeks Lavender Farm**  
Distance: 17 Miles
- 1:15–2:30**      **Tour Twin Creeks Lavender Farm**  
Features: Walk around the lavender plants and take a deep breath to relax your mind and body. This farm grows seven colorful varieties of lavender including Grosso, Grosso Bleu, Royal Velvet, Violet Intrigue, Melissa, and Provence. Gift shops are on site to buy a variety of lavender products.
- 2:30–3:15**      **Drive to Greenbrier Farms**  
Distance: 27 miles
- 3:15–4:00**      **Arrive at Greenbrier Farms for a tour**  
Features: Discover all the features of this sustainable and regenerative practice for grass-fed and finished beef, pasture-raised pork, and seasonal produce, including how they supply many area restaurants with their products.
- 4:00–4:30**      **Drive to Table Rock Tea Farm**  
Distance: 13 miles

**Tour of Table Rock Tea Company Farm**

Features: This tea farm is one of only about five certified sites in America. Tour the greenhouse and tea fields to learn how the plant is grown, then experience the processing plant to see how they turn the leaves into Oolong, Green and Black Tea varieties.

**Drive to Topsoil Restaurant**

Distance: 18 miles

**5:30–6:30**

**Dinner at Topsoil Restaurant**

Features: A farm-to-table style cuisine utilizing the freshest of ingredients to provide an unforgettable and mouthwatering meal.
