Enjoy year-round fishing, campsites, birding and wildlife observation areas, hiking trails, fossil pit, picnic shelters with grills, and pedal boating by reservation. Learn about Eastern NC science and nature with exhibits including a turtle touch tank, waterfowl of the Atlantic Flyway, a 10,000-gallon freshwater aquarium, live snakes, a North American Diorama, and a 70-seat theater.

Wildwood Park 😩

Explore Greenville's newest park featuring 360 acres of woodlands, waterways, and trails. Connected to the Tar River, the lakes of Wildwood feature an accessible kayak launch, floating dock with 3 boat slips, a waterfront camping platform, and more. On land, find miles of walking trails, 6 miles of single-track trails at the Chris Smith Mountain Bike Trails, a BMX Pump Track and Bicycle Skills Course, playground, welcome center, and more!
