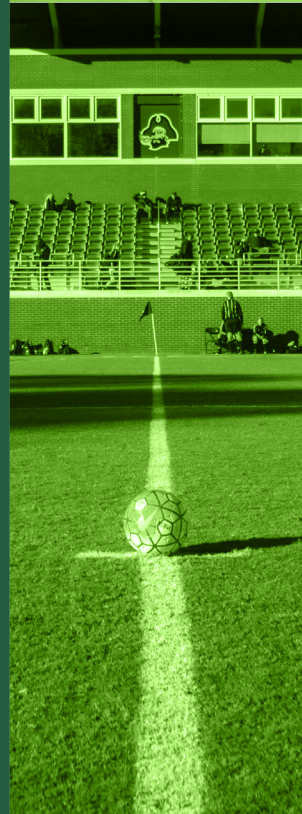
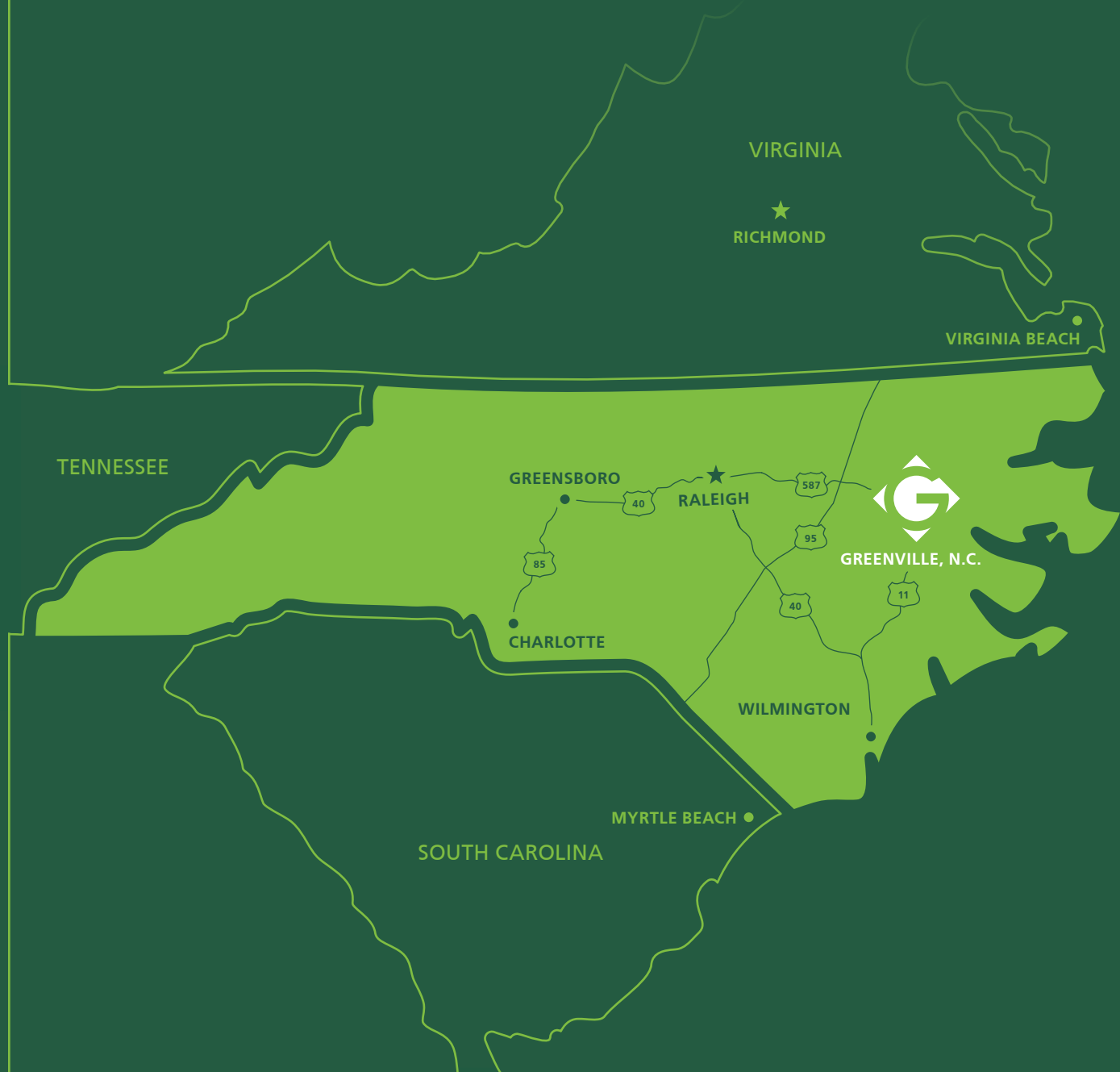

GETTING HERE

Most major Southeastern metropolitan areas are within a day's drive of Greenville, which is accessible from the east and west via I-587, and north and south via I-95.

These cities include Raleigh, Atlanta, Wilmington, Greensboro, Virginia Beach, Myrtle Beach, Richmond, Baltimore, Charlotte and Washington, D.C. Located in the city of Greenville is the Pitt-Greenville Airport, which is served by American Airlines. Greenville is less than a 100 mile drive from Raleigh and RDU International Airport, which is served by most major airlines.

- Six (6) acres of water for fishing and boating, a sunbathing sand beach, fitness equipment, a .5 mile lake trail and beach volleyball court

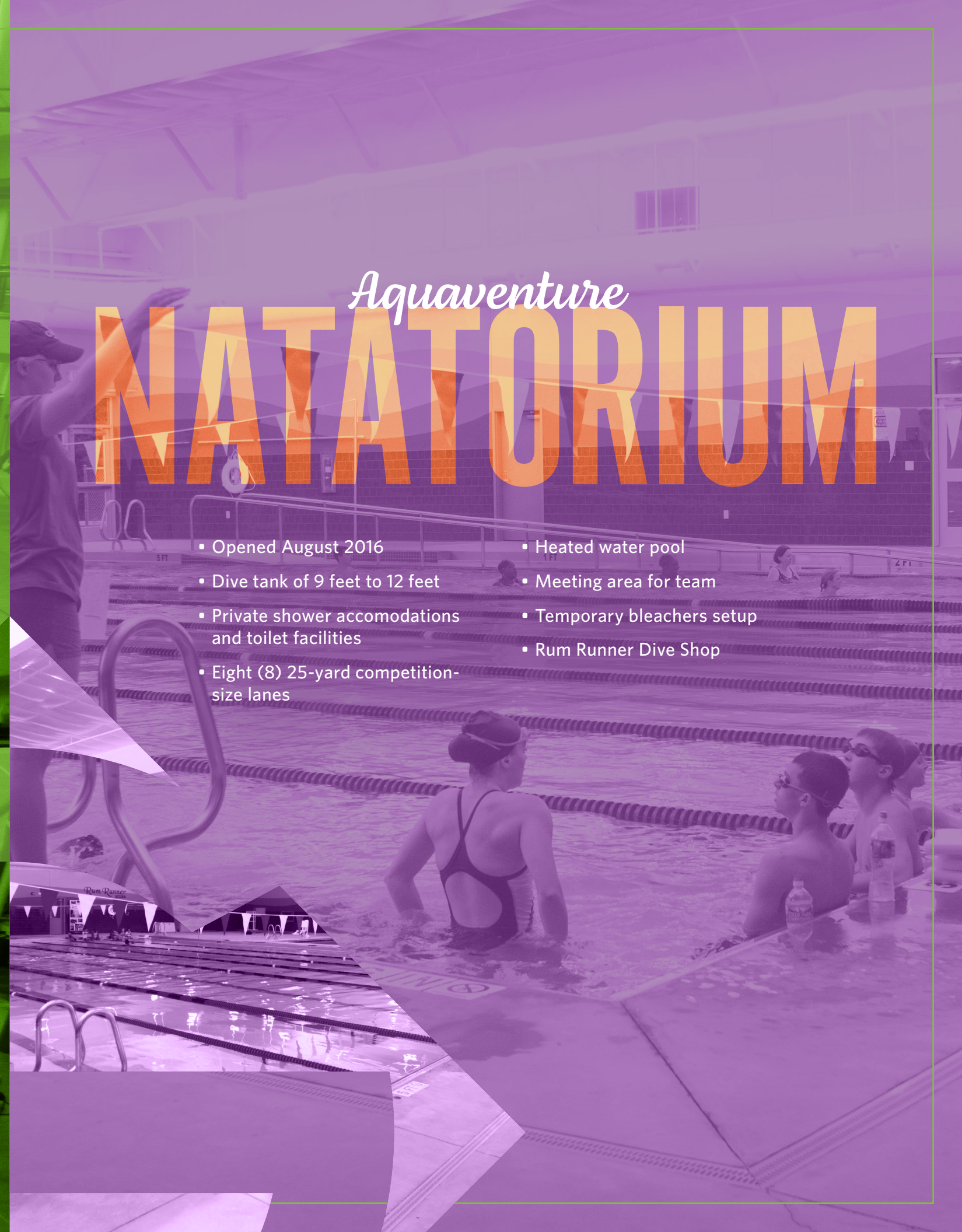

DISC GOLF

Greenville-Pitt County is a hot bed for Disc Golf! We are home to five regulation 18-hole courses, all of which have hosted local and regional tournaments. Our local disc golf community is strong and active, and is an asset to the Sports Commission when hosting tournaments!

- Five regulation length 18-hole disc golf courses
- History of hosting A-tier PDGA Tournaments
- Courses maintained by East Carolina University, City of Greenville, Town of Farmville, and Town of Ayden
- Courses vary in difficulty, players from novice to advanced will enjoy the layouts
- Greenville Disc Golf has hosted weekly, monthly, and annual events for over 15 years
