


Pace Report - Pipeline



Organic Traffic Summary

Organic sessions were up 22% over last year. Events dominated the top 10 landing pages. The events section (content + details) was up 25% YoY. Aside from Events, content that contributed to the growth included the Homepage (+157%), the Jones Park listing (+553%), and the Ocean Springs page (+463%).

Other YoY organic highlights: Bounce rate improved by 2%, average session duration up 2%, and referrals from listings up 24% and from events up 46%..

Mississippi Aquarium — Gulfport, Mississippi

The Mississippi Aquarium has one of the most incredible experiences you can have without going out scuba diving. It's called SeaTrek and you can literally swim with the fishes (in a good way.)

The Coastal Mississippi Coffee Trail

Gulf Coast Coffee- The Birthplace of Coffee in America

The Brits have their tea, and the French have their coffee. Long before coffee shops sprung up in Boston after that famous tea party, French settlers were brewing beans on the bayou. 1699 saw the first permanent European settlement on the Gulf Coast, Fort Maurepas, near Ocean Springs, Mississippi.

New Orleans, founded in 1718, became one of the largest importers of coffee in the United States. With the blockade of the harbor during the Civil War, New Orleanians stretched their coffee stores by mixing in roasted chicory root. Being good southerners, they'd also add a little lard to give the chicory a little face. After the war, the city remained a culinary hub for America, which is an attitude and tradition that extends along the Gulf Coast.

Mississippi: Bankhouse Coffee



This shop in Long Beach along Mississippi's scenic Gulf coastline is housed in a 1924 bank building, listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Reminders of its financial history remain with the original vault on the ground floor, with photos from Long Beach's first post office adorning the walls.

But Bankhouse is a lot more than a history museum. It also serves up its brand name Coast Roast coffee, the most recognized flavor in the region, plus a whole slew of baked goods that make breakfast here the ideal way to start a day exploring Mississippi.




