As the storm surge engulfed one resident's home, she, along with her terrier Maddy and two of her neighbors, desperately clung to a large branch of an oak tree in her backyard. They clung to this branch for hours about 20 feet above the storm surge. Even at this height, the waves were still washing over them. She says that after the waters receded, they were able to climb down and see that the life-saving tree had been damaged beyond retrieval, after it had literally saved their lives.


