DAY 1

If you are looking for groceries for the weekend, stop in at Duren's Piggly Wiggly and shop around. While in Port St. Joe, pick up some kayaks and paddleboards from Daly's Watersports, so you are prepared for tomorrow's adventure! Enjoy dinner around the firepit tonight located at the campground.

DAY 2

Enjoy sunrise over Indian Pass Lagoon while sipping coffee from the General Store. Pack a lunch, and don't forget plenty of water, sunscreen, and some bug spray for a morning paddle across to St. Vincent Island Wildlife Refuge. After getting cleaned up from your paddle, it's time to hit the town for a little more sightseeing. Head to Port St. Joe for dinner. Pre-dinner make sure to visit the Cape San Blas Lighthouse! Have dinner on the patio tonight at Krazyfish Grill. The menu consists of something for everyone. They serve up delicious shrimp and grits to juicy hamburgers.



DAY 3

Set off exploring early by heading to Weber's Donuts on Cape San Blas located at the Cape Trading Post. Get there early! Shelling is different on every beach in Gulf County so enjoy the morning breeze while beachcombing on Cape San Blas. After shelling, grab lunch at Cape Trading Post for a picnic in St. Joseph Peninsula State Park. Plan a horseback ride on the beach with Broke-a-Toe. You can enjoy a sunset ride or let them customize a package for you. For dinner tonight, stay close to "home" by enjoying the famous Indian Pass Raw Bar that is located just across the road from Water's Edge RV Park



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
