### **GULF COUNTY PARK POLICIES & REQUIREMENTS**

- Fee Schedule attached (2017)
- No alcohol shall be permitted without prior approval of the reviewing County Official for any FUA event. Alcohol consumption only in designated areas upon written authorization from County Officials.
- All for profit FUA permits shall be required to provide approved event insurance as directed by County Official.
- Site Plan for proposed park area to be reserved must be attached to your application.
- Deposit (\$200) for the event is to be received along with park fee and full application to secure reservation.
- All plants, animals and park property are protected. The collection, destruction or disturbance of plants, animals or park property is prohibited.
- Pets are permitted in designated areas only. Where allowed, pets must be kept on a hand-held leash, no longer than 6 feet at all times. Service animals are welcome in all areas of the park.
- Fishing, boating, swimming and fires are allowed in designated areas only.
- Fireworks are prohibited in all Gulf County Parks.

Full acknowledge and acceptance of these policies and requirements:

- Hunting is prohibited in all Gulf County Parks.
- Sales Tax and cleaning fees are included in the attached fees schedule rates.
- Complete all checklist items & return building keys the following business day to receive your deposit refund. (Allow 7 to 14 days to receive a check from the county clerk via US mail.)

I fully understand that this application does not confirm any request until it has been signed, dated and approved by an authorized Gulf County employee, at which time a permit will be given to me or my representative, or mailed to the address designated above. If applicable, I understand that I will be informed prior to my event of any requirements for additional fees to be charged and collected for county, TDC, park or administrative staff. I further affirm that I have completed this application with as much accuracy and detail as possible. Applicants agrees to hold Gulf County, its agents and employees harmless for any and all acts and/or omissions, and accepts sole responsibility for usages of the facilities. # ORDINANCE NO. 2017- O4

AN ORDINANCE OF GULF COUNTY, FLORIDA; ESTABLISHING GULF COUNTY PARKS POLICY AND APPLICATION ORDINANCE AND SHALL BE COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS THE "GULF COUNTY PARKS POLICY" ORDINANCE WHEREIN GULF COUNTY ADOPTS, INSTITUTTES AND IMPLEMENTS THE GULF COUNTY PARKS POLICIES, GUIDELINES, APPLICATION FOR RESERVATION AND USE OF COUNTY PARKS AND OR COUNTY FACILITY USAGES PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER, PROVIDING FOR ADMINSTRATIVE OVERSIGHT; SEVERABILITY AND MODIFICATIONS THAT MAY ARISE FROM CONSIDERATION AT PUBLIC HEARINGS; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Gulf County Florida (hereinafter Commission) find and determine that Gulf County in its continued efforts to maintain, preserve and enhance the Gulf County park system has adopted through action of the Commissioners, the following Gulf County Parks Policy and Application; and

WHEREAS, the Commission after several years of careful review and consideration of the current park improvements and availability have deemed it timely and appropriate for Gulf County to adopt the Parks Policy and Application to preserve and promote the continued quality of life for all citizens and visitors to County; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has received the recommendations of the County staff and through public hearings on the issue to review the proper implementation and procedures to establish a policy and application process to reserve a section of a passive county park or a community center to preserve and balance the interests of all citizens and visitors to Gulf County; and

WHEREAS, the Commission and staff have received comment and public input from residents and owners through public hearing; and

WHEREAS, on October 5, 2017 a Public Notice was advertised in The News Herald offering the public an opportunity to participate at a public hearing before the Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) on October 17, 2017 at 10:00 am for the adoption of this proposed ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Commission hereinafter shall commonly refer to this Ordinance as the "Gulf County Parks Policy" and its adoption shall be considered further for incorporation and consistency with the Gulf County Land Development Regulations; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Gulf County, in the State of Florida as follows:

### Section 1 - Short Title.

This Ordinance shall hereafter be known and referred to as the "Gulf County Parks Policy".

# Section 2 - Authority.

This ordinance is adopted by the Gulf County Commission in accordance with and under the authoritative powers permitted by home rule, the County's police powers to protect the public health, safety and welfare, and under the powers pursuant to the authority granted under Florida Statute 125 for the implementation and enforcement of standards, rules and regulations set forth herein.

# Section 3 - Purpose.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to preserve, protect, enhance and promote the Gulf County Park System for its citizens and visitors alike.

# Section 4 - Policy and Application

It is the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that the attached Gulf County Park Policy and Application be adopted through this ordinance and be subject to annual review and revisions upon recommendations by the Gulf County Administration and Gulf County Parks Director. The attached policies, application form and fee schedule shall be subject to an annual administrative review and revisions and thereafter ratified following a duly notice public hearing by the Gulf County Commission on or before the anniversary of this ordinance adoption.

# Section 5 - Codification

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Ordinance will become and be made a part of the Gulf County Land Development Regulations; and that sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or re-lettered and that the word "Ordinance" may be changed to "section", "article", or such other appropriate word or phrase in order to accomplish such intention; and regardless of whether such inclusion in the LDR is accomplished, sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or re-lettered and typographical errors which do not affect the intent may be authorized by the County Administrator, or the County Administrator's designee, without need of public hearing, by filing a corrected or re-codified copy of same with the County Clerk of Circuit Court.

### Section 6. Penalties.

Any person or entity who violates any provision of this ordinance, or who fails to comply therewith, shall be subject to the penalties as prescribed in Gulf County and/or as provided by law.

### Section 7. Severability.

It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County Commissioners of Gulf County, Florida, that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance shall be construed as not having contained said section, subsection, sentence, clause, or provision, and shall not be affected by such holding.

### Section 8. Codification.

It is the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Ordinance may be modified as a result of considerations that may arise during the noticed public hearing. Such modifications shall be incorporated into the final version of the Ordinance and adopted by the Board and filed by the Clerk to the Board.

# Section 9. Repealer

Any and all ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of any conflict.

### Section 10. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
