FROM THE SOUTH

Just down the road from Gulf County is Wakulla Springs State Park. Hop on one of their riverboats to see the diverse wildlife that can be found. Boat tours do require reservations! Then in Gulf County, take an Eco Tour through Lake Wimico to see different types of wildlife!

FROM THE NORTH

Get up close and personal with a multitude of different animals at Wild Animal Safari in Pine Mountain, Ga.

Once you arrive in Gulf County, look up, look down, look everywhere for your own personal encounter with our wildlife. Here is a tip: check out T. H. Stone Memorial St. Joseph Peninsula State Park.

FROM THE WEST

Protection is critical for any nature lover. Get an experience of a lifetime at Seacrest Wolf Sanctuary in Chipley, Fl. You do need a reservation to tour! In Gulf County, we also protect our essential creatures, so make sure to check out the Forgotten Coast Sea Turtle Center!

FROM THE MIDWEST

Stretch your legs and explore Mammoth Cave in Kentucky, the longest cave system known in the world. Once you arrive in Gulf County, plan to explore St. Joseph Bay State Buffer Preserve and its trail system. They have over 5,000 acres of trails full of endangered fauna and flora. Make sure to visit the Welcome Center and the Lookout Tower that allows you to view St. Joseph Bay.
