Located in the heart of downtown Sugar Hill's "Shine District," Sugar Hill Distillery is the first in the nation distillery to manufacture and produce both fine spirits and German style beer with the same equipment. Add a full-service restaurant to the mix and you have the perfect place for a relaxing and memorable day or evening of delicious Euro-inspired treats, fine spirits, and delicious craft beers.

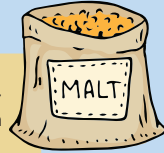
Indio Brewing

A Lucha Libre mural featuring a masked wrestler sets the tone at this Latin-owned and operated hotspot in Sugar Hill. Enjoy craft cervezas, from hazy IPAs to sours, stouts, and more. Expect plenty of tropical fruit infusions (we like the Don Ramon New England IPA, with flavors of tangerine, mango, and pineapple), plus comedy, bingo, and karaoke nights.



6S Brewing Co.

Exposed brick adds character to this tasting room housed in a fully restored, 145-year-old building in historic downtown Duluth. This family-run operation pours a variety of beers from Soft Tail Hefeweizen to Duluth Imperial Pale. Bring in some food and the family to play one of the many board games available.

StillFire Brewing

Brewers here are riding high from championship wins, including a medal for their Black Mask Imperial Stout, judged "Best Strong Beer in Georgia" for 2021. Sample it and at least 25 other selections (craft root beer, too), plus food truck eats, at this dog-friendly brew garden adjacent to Suwanee Town Center Park.

Good Word Brewing

Owners Todd DiMatteo and Ryan Skinner, both former employees of famed Brick Store Pub in Decatur, carry on the tradition of quality brewing, curated comfort food, and community building. Fans of the spot's burger, with caramelized onions and special sauce include iconic chef Wolfgang Puck. Wash it down with Any Day Now, an Italian Pilsner.

Monkey Wrench Brewing

Located on the edge of Suwanee Creek Greenway Trail, this family business is expanding, and a 200-gallon distillery system means cocktails and a tiki bar will soon be in the mix. Meanwhile, there are up to 15 beers on tap, plus cornhole tournaments, weekend concerts, and food trucks to keep thirsty regulars happy.

Peachtree Corners



Social Fox Brewing Co.

Outside Norcross's first craft brewery is a mural titled Tumblefield depicting a pair of foxes rollicking together. That playful mood carries over to the newly expanded space. Billing itself as "small, social, and hyperlocal," the brewery hosts fun events, including open mic and trivia nights.

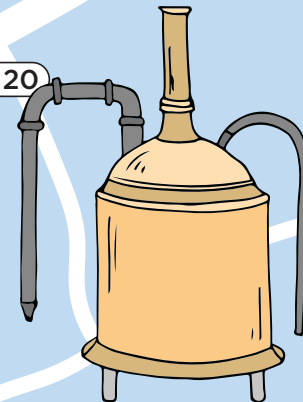


Cultivation Brewing

Once a garment factory, the interior features a stylish bar, wood tables, and rustic brick walls. Beers on tap, signature brews, limited releases, and seasonal pours fuel game-day parties and nightly events.
