In July 1892, two men driving a wagon on the Cicero Pike [Highway 19] spotted a large animal in the river at this site. The newspaper described it as “a huge serpent, 12 feet in length and perhaps 3 feet in circumference with a forked tail.” Later that month, four men on a fishing trip discovered what they thought may have been the object – the carcass of a dead cow caught on some floating branches.
