1.) **Office Volunteering:** Fishers North Office/Warehouse Location

Typically, office reception/volunteer positions are based on commitments for 6-12 months, with a consistency of shifts (am or pm)

2.) **Mobile Food Distribution:** Various Locations as Announced

Help with food distribution at all locations.

Dates and times vary according to distribution dates as announced online on iVolunteer page.

3.) **Warehouse Volunteering:** Fishers South Office/Warehouse

Help with unloading & stocking shelves.

4.) **Group Volunteering:** Various Locations as Announced

Limited "group" volunteering is scheduled throughout the week and sometimes during the weekends. Typically, groups are needed and are very busy during the holiday season. To schedule, groups must use a "Group iVolunteer Request Form," available online. You will receive a confirmation of your request and a follow-up concerning your request options and availability.

5.) **Holiday Volunteering:** Various Locations as Announced

Typically, volunteer opportunities are announced and available for online sign-up within the first few weeks of October annually.

5.) **Transportation Team**
