

Explore at new heights in Hamilton County, Indiana

KOTEEWI AERIAL ADVENTURE PARK AND TREETOP TRAILS 11800 Koteewi Drive, Noblesville

Trail systems are no longer confined to ground level at Strawtown Koteewi Park in Noblesville. Clip in and take to the trees for obstacle courses at three levels: 15, 30 and 50 feet. Unlike other courses of its kind, the Koteewi Aerial Adventure experience was custom built to the existing forestry, meaning no outside poles or posts are present in the design. Kids must be 7 years old to complete the trails.

TREETOP OUTPOST AT CONNER PRAIRIE 13400 Allisonville Road, Fishers

Conner Prairie's new experience area, Treetop Outpost, reminiscent of Swiss Family Robinson-esque architecture features a 6,000-square-foot exhibit, with a four-story tree house as the centerpiece. This experience aims to educate guests on the bounty of Indiana's natural resources. After viewing the Nature Walk trail and White River vista from above, kids can dig in a recreated archaeology site, build a log cabin like Hoosiers from the past, create art and fill the forest with music with natural materials.

16141 East 101st Street, Fishers Forget the playground – Flat Fork Creek Park encourages kids to use their explorer sensibilities with three tree houses scattered along a wooded trail. Climb the 60-foot "mountain" (or sledding hill, depending on the season) for more aerial views of fall foliage.

1859 BALLOON VOYAGE AT CONNER PRAIRIE 13400 Allisonville Road, Fishers

The tethered helium balloon elevates guests 350 feet above the prairie to behold acres of green in the summer and autumn leaves in the fall.

KOTEEWI RANGE: SPORT & TARGET ARCHERY CENTER 22735 Essig Avenue, Noblesville

Take aim on outdoor fun at this Olympic-size facility. Offering safety and educational classes, you'll be on target in no time.

25440 Scherer Avenue, Arcadia

Enjoy bird watching? Visit the Rookery Preserve where nearly 100 Great Blue Heron nests are in the area. Recommended viewing times are March - April (possibly May) when vegetation is low.

WHITE RIVER CANOE COMPANY 17180 River Avenue, Noblesville

Float the White River in a canoe, kayak, or river tube on any one of nine trips that span 28 miles of the river as it meanders through Hamilton County.
