Maryland Department of Commerce, Office of Tourism Allocates \$80,000 Toward The Gateway to Freedom Ride Along Route 40

[Bel Air, MD] – Visit Harford was recently awarded \$80,000 of grand funding by The Maryland Department of Commerce, Office of Tourism to support The Gateway to Freedom Ride Along Route 40 in Harford County. This grant will be used to create an economic impact by increasing tourism in Harford County and throughout Maryland.
