

Transportation

AMTRAK

Enjoy the convenience of traveling to the Hershey Harrisburg Region with **Amtrak** service. Arrive at the Downtown Harrisburg (HAR) station for quick access to the Capital City, or the Middletown (MID) station. Summer




Summer. Say it out loud and it's a word that smiles. A season that shines not just for its sunny days but for its universal relationship to VACATION!

It’s all fun and games at **Adventure Sports**. Who will take the checkered flag on the go-cart track, set a new high score in the arcade, or blast the longest line drive in the batting cages? It’s always 52 degrees at **Echo Dell at Indian Echo Caverns** where guests explore fascinating limestone formations on guided tours.

Hockey fans in the fam? Check out the **Hershey Bears®** schedule to watch the 13-time AHL Calder Cup champions skate deeper into the history books!

Walk on the wild side at **Lake Tobias Wildlife Park**, a 150-acre park with more than 1,000 animals! Experience an open-air safari tour, petting zoo, and exhibits featuring extraordinary animals like reticulated giraffes, reptiles, and exotics.

At **ZooAmerica®**, see more than 200 animals native to North America. From black bears to bobcats, you'll learn amazing facts about animals that roam the continent.

With its 500 acres of rustic beauty, guided walks, lectures, and other special events, the **Ned Smith Center for Nature and Art** is a bucket list stop for any family that enjoys learning about wildlife and the outdoors. Budding birdwatchers in your crew? The **Olewine Nature Center at Wildwood Park** has bird guides, binoculars, and interactive resources that make it easy for kids to have a hands-on experience close to nature. The streams and trails at **Little Buffalo State Park** are prime spots to see tracks of beaver, muskrat, and mink. The park's Holman Lake provides habitat for many species of fish and waterfowl.






Peter's Mountain

Hiking

When we talk trails, we're not talking about plain old paths. Several of the region's best hiking trails intersect with or share sections of the famed Appalachian Trail. The payoff views atop **Hawk Rock** and **Peter's Mountain** are worth the climb! The Appalachian Trail Conservancy estimates 3,000 people a year attempt to hike the entire 2,197-mile trail between Maine and Georgia, but fewer than 1,000 complete the bucket list accomplishment.

Just outside the City of Harrisburg, **Wildwood Park** features scenic wetlands and elevated boardwalk trails. Go hiking or biking, explore the nature center, and watch for special programming like festivals, walks/runs, and wildlife photography sessions. A few miles to the north, you'll find the huge expanse of **Detweiler Park** with its gorgeous vistas and miles of nature trails.

Biking

Exploring on two wheels? Chase an adrenaline rush on the challenging terrain of a mountain bike trail or cruise around town with a convenient rental from the [SusqueCycle](#) bike share program.

Did you know? The 20+ mile [Rattling Creek Trail System](#) is one of only two EPIC rated systems in Pennsylvania and one of just a handful across the entire East Coast. EPICs are bucket-list destinations for many mountain bikers, delivering intense backcountry riding experiences.

A ten-mile trail system near Hershey Medical Center features trails on the “West Side” with rugged terrain and an “East Side” with more open trails for beginner and novice riders.

The 24-mile [Capital Area Greenbelt](#) connects Harrisburg area neighborhoods, natural spaces, and historic landmarks with featured stretches near [Wildwood, Fort Hunter, and Riverfront](#) parks. In June, join thousands of riders for the annual [Tour de Belt](#) event.



Disc Golf

Chase an ace! Find a disc golf course and take in the beautiful scenery of local parks and outdoor spaces. From Wiconisco Creek Disc Golf Course that winds and undulates along the creek to the expansive layout of Shank Park near Hershey, there are courses to fit any skill level.

Perry County

Neighboring the Hershey Harrisburg Region to the west, Perry County's scenic views and winding trails invite outdoor enthusiasts to enjoy picturesque hikes and activities. Hawk Rock rightly gets the raptor's share of attention for its place on the AT and panoramic views, but you can also explore miles of trails at **Little Buffalo State Park** and **Cove Mountain**.

The **Millersburg Ferry** is the last operational wooden double-stern paddle boat in the U.S. The Roaring Bull V is the latest in a line of ferries that has continuously connected visitors between Dauphin and Perry counties since 1827.
