L1: Exhibit Halls and Lobby

Level 1 includes a 204,249 sq.ft. (18,975 sq m) exhibit hall and a 35,000 sq. ft. (3,252 sq m) registration lobby

Parking is on Level 2 with 690 parking stalls

L3: Meeting Rooms

Level 3 contains 138,869 sq. ft. (12,902 sq m) of total meeting space including 47 meeting rooms and two theaters with tiered seating



L4: Ballroom and Rooftop Garden

Level 4 features a 35,000 sq. ft. (3,276 sq m) grand ballroom and a 2.5-acre (10,117 sq m) landscaped rooftop garden for receptions
