HAWAI'I VISITORS AND CONVENTION BUREAU HELPS BRING ALOHA TO HOLLYWOOD AS A SPONSOR OF THE WORLD PREMIERE OF DISNEY'S "LILO & STITCH"

HVCB Brings the Spirit of Hawai'i to a Global Stage Through Cultural Protocol and Hula

LOS ANGELES – The Hawai'i Visitors and Convention Bureau (HVCB) was a proud sponsor of the world premiere of Disney's *Lilo & Stitch*, held on Saturday, 17 May at the El Capitan Theatre in Hollywood. The premiere of the live-action reimagining—written by Native Hawaiian filmmaker and screenwriter Chris Kekaniokalani Bright—attracted international attention and brought together cast, crew, and distinguished guests, including Hawai'i State Senator Lynn DeCoite and Hawai'i State Representative Shirley Ann Templo in celebration of the new movie landing in theaters 23 May.

In collaboration with Disney, HVCB ensured that elements of Hawaiian culture were respectfully and meaningfully represented throughout the event. The program opened with traditional Hawaiian protocol led by Kumu Hula Lilinoe Kaio of Hula Hālau 'o Lilinoe and Nā Pua me ke Aloha. This moment of cultural grounding set the tone for the afternoon and reflected the importance of place, respect, and intention. Jaedyn Janae Puahaulani Pavao, newly crowned 2025 Miss Aloha Hula—one of hula's most respected titles—was also present to represent Kaua'i and Hawai'i, bringing another layer of cultural significance to the event and honoring the importance of hula in the story that *Lilo & Stitch* brings to life.

"This premiere wasn't just a celebration of a film—it was an opportunity to elevate the people, culture, and stories that define our Hawai'i," said Dr. Aaron J. Salā, president and CEO of HVCB. "As audiences reconnect with *Lilo & Stitch*, we invite them to reconnect with Hawai'i thoughtfully—to engage with our Hawai'i in ways that deepen their understanding of our communities and values."

As part of the celebration, HVCB member and fellow premiere sponsor, Hawaiian Airlines welcomed guests with lei and a photo opportunity. The airline recently launched <u>Searching for Stitch</u>, an augmented reality experience that guides users through iconic sites across the Hawaiian Islands. Each stop reflects the pillars of Hawaiian Airlines' Travel Pono program, which encourages mindful, responsible travel.

The festivities began with a "blue carpet" arrival and a lively pre-party that included keiki (children) activities, Stitch character appearances, and themed refreshments, followed by the film's first public screening.

Disney's Lilo & Stitch opens in theaters nationwide on 23 May 2025.
