Monthly Hawaii Hotel Performance Report for May 2020

Excerpt: According to the Hawaii Hotel Performance Report published by the Hawaii Tourism Authority's (HTA) Tourism Research Division, statewide RevPAR decreased to \$18 (-91.1%), ADR fell to \$127 (-50.4%), and occupancy declined to 14.2 percent (-64.9 percentage points) in May.

Hawaii Vacation Rental Report for May 2020

Excerpt: In May 2020, the total monthly supply of statewide vacation rentals was 326,200 unit nights (-64.8%) and monthly demand was 30,600 unit nights (-95.3%), resulting in an average monthly unit occupancy of 9.4 percent (-61.7 percentage points).

Updated STR forecast

Excerpt: U.S. hotel demand not expected to fully recover until 2023.
