New Online Safe Travels Form

Launched on September 1st, the new <u>Safe Travels form</u> is a digital form that is mandatory for all travelers to Hawaii. This new online form will provide the State Department of Health (DOH) access to the mandatory health information that passengers need to provide to monitor and protect public health in real-time. It can also be used by the Dept. of the Attorney General and county law enforcement officials to enforce the quarantine rules. Travelers are encouraged to enter their information and trip details well in advance of their flight.

Lieutenant Governor's Request for Volunteers

There is an urgent need to provide support in areas around contact tracing and general public health awareness. The Lieutenant Governor office is seeking volunteers that can help make first calls to COVID+ cases.



The first callers will be making initial calls to

cases to free up time for investigators and contact tracers to do investigations into clusters. There are no requirements for volunteers, other than that they must be at least 18 years of age and be available to donate a few hours once or preferably twice a week at the Convention Center. Each volunteer will go through 3 hours of training before they begin making calls.
