

Hendricks County COVID-19 Hotel Data Monthly Report

Through the Month of May 2020

According to STR, May U.S. hotel occupancy dropped about 52% to **33.1%** and RevPAR declined 71% to **\$26.35**. While significantly below 2019 levels, both stats show improvement over April.

In comparison, **Hendricks County performed better than the national average** in both Occupancy and RevPAR in May.

When comparing May averages with surrounding Indiana counties, Hendricks County:

- Has the 2nd highest average Occupancy.
- Ranked 2nd in average RevPAR.
- Fared better than the average YOY decline in both stats.
