Throughout the guide and on the cover, you'll notice custom cookies created by Mama Bird Bakery, a Plainfield cafe that does more than just offer delicious treats.

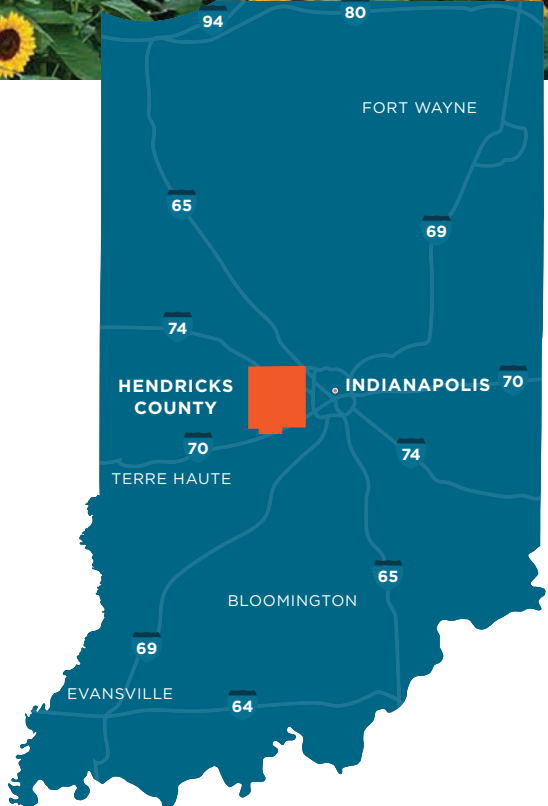

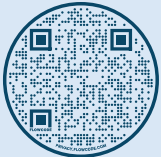

Meet the Towns

Whether you live right in the heart of Hendricks County or you're a few hours away, there's something for you to enjoy here. Read on to meet our towns and learn what makes each one special. Once you've read up on our towns, plan a trip and join us as we celebrate 25 years of welcoming visitors to Hendricks County!

Meet Avon

Visitors will find just about every nationally recognized store and restaurant that can be imagined, as well as locally owned gems such as The Tie Dye Lab, Avon Gardens and the Red Curb Improv Comedy Theatre. U.S. 36 runs through the center of town, connecting it to Indianapolis.

Insider tip: One of our favorite places in Avon is Washington Township Park, where you'll find a huge playground, a dog park, a splash pad, trails, a wonderful Pavilion Center (that can be used for meetings and weddings) and more.

Meet Brownsburg

Located in the northeast corner of the county, I-74 runs through Brownsburg, as does U.S. 136, and the town has the county's second-largest cluster of hotels. Most known as a motorsports haven, Lucas Oil Indianapolis Raceway Park resides in Brownsburg. Its drag strip and paved oval track host a slew of racing events including the NHRA U.S. Nationals, the biggest drag racing event of the year, every Labor Day weekend.

Insider tip: Stop by Natural Valley Ranch, a working horse farm that offers horseback riding excursions and other activities.

Meet Danville

People who love art, music and community events will love Danville. It's home to the Gallery on the Square, and the Hendricks County History Museum. Just west of town, Beasley's Orchard is a fall staple. Danville events include the annual Hendricks County 4-H Fair, First Friday Cruise-Ins, Heartland Apple Festival and much more.

Insider tip: Danville is also home to the only bed & breakfast in the county, the quaint Marmalade Sky. Book your stay today!

Meet West Hendricks County

The western half of Hendricks County remains rural with a few small towns scattered about including Amo, Clayton, Lizton, North Salem and Pittsboro, among others.

Despite its sparse population, the area provides some great attractions if you know where to look, including the best BBQ in central Indiana at a little shack by the tracks, Rusted Silo Southern BBQ & Brewhouse. A couple other dining hidden gems can be found in Pittsboro at Hoosier Roots and in North Salem at Perillo's Pizzeria, which is owned and operated by a man with ties to Sicily.

While in North Salem, you also should check out the expansive McCloud Nature Park, which is known for its scenic nature trails, nationally recognized fall foliage and a historic iron truss bridge spanning over White Lick Creek.

Insider Tip: We highly recommend visiting Clayton while in western Hendricks County. This up-and-coming small town continues to add experiences including Copper Top Customs, which has become a shopping delight, and Ms. B's Teas where you can enjoy tea and other goodies.

Meet Plainfield

This beautiful and historic town in the southeastern portion of the county is accessible by both I-70 and the National Road—also known as U.S. 40. It's right next door to the Indianapolis International Airport and boasts the county's largest cluster of hotels.

Visitors to Plainfield can enjoy the large outdoor shopping mall called The Shops at Perry Crossing, the historic Oasis Diner, family-friendly activities, entertainment and lots of locally owned shops and establishments.

Insider tip: Visit the newly expanded Splash Island Family Water Park, use the fantastic trail system or head to Echo Hollow Nature Park to get out in nature.

Outdoor Activities

Oinking Acres Farm Rescue & Sanctuary

Calling all animal enthusiasts! Your heart will find a special place at Oinking Acres Farm Rescue & Sanctuary when you learn about its founder and her mission. This enchanting farm is a haven for rescued pigs, goats, cows, chickens and a host of other adorable creatures.

If you are looking for the perfect place to create a unique family experience, plan on a farm tour that lets you get acquainted with these furry (yes, pigs have fur!) residents, or take it a step further by volunteering to contribute to their care. It’s an experience that brings you face-to-face with some of the most lovable and grateful companions you’ll ever meet.

Beasley’s Orchard

Beasley’s Orchard beckons for a day of outdoor delights and fresh produce! Handpick apples, pumpkins and seasonal treasures or take a charming hayride through the sprawling orchard. Kids can revel in a whimsical corn maze and a playground.

And for your taste buds, the farm’s bakery offers delectable treats crafted from fresh, farm-grown produce. Agricultural Tourism is a fantastic way to support your local farmers – it ranks right up there with shopping at your local farmers’ market. Make sure you wet your whistle with the *Best Apple Cider in Indiana!* Two more words for you: apple cannons!

Echo Hollow Nature Park

Located in Plainfield, Echo Hollow Nature Park stands as a testament to conservation and coexistence. As you traverse the park’s scenic miles of nature trails, pause to admire the butterfly garden and observe the serene fishing pond; you’re not only witnessing nature’s wonders but also supporting the park’s mission to protect and educate.

Hot Blown Glass

We made our own pumpkin paperweights, and it surprised me what I could create in roughly 10 minutes. Be sure to make a reservation though as this fine arts experience isn’t open to the public.

Schakolad Chocolate Factory

Calling all sweet aficionados! Schakolad Chocolate Factory, a cherished family-owned haven, offers a delectable array of handmade chocolates, truffles and other sugary delights. Watch the chocolate maestros craft their masterpieces through the viewing window and get ready to satisfy your cravings.

Are you like me and think that chocolate should be the fifth food group with three servings a day? Dive even deeper with their chocolate-making classes, perfect for those eager to whip up their own cocoa-infused creations.

The Tie Dye Lab

Unleash your creativity at The Tie Dye Lab, a hub of colorful fun. Take your pick from a selection of clothing items, from tees to socks, and dive into the world of tie-dye. With expert guidance and all the essentials provided, it’s a fantastic choice for family bonding or hanging out with friends.

They walk you through different techniques on the tying part and what colors would work well together—ensuring you end up with the perfect masterpiece.

From cozy cafes serving inventive dishes to nostalgic-themed eateries and retro diners, there's something to satisfy every palate. For those craving classic barbecue or craft beer, you'll find joints that epitomize authenticity.

Bread Basket Cafe and Bakery

For a cozy and inviting ambiance, head to Bread Basket Cafe and Bakery. This family-owned gem offers a delightful range of American classics, as well as inventive dishes. From their signature cinnamon roll French toast to beloved chicken and waffles, and not forgetting the scrumptious homemade pies and cakes, every bite is a flavor-packed journey.

Pie. I said Pie—and they make adorable personal-sized ones called Sweetie Pies that you don't have to share (if you don't want to).

Mayberry Cafe

Fans of *The Andy Griffith Show* will find a haven at the Mayberry Cafe. Immersed in the show's charm, this themed eatery serves up hearty portions of classic American favorites. Dive into dishes like fried chicken, meatloaf and heavenly homemade pies. With generous servings and wallet-friendly prices, it's a nostalgic culinary adventure. I had the Otis Whiskey Burger.

Oasis Diner

A historical treasure since 1954, Oasis Diner carries on the legacy of classic diner fare. Revived in 2014, its retro interior takes you on a journey to the past. From mouthwatering burgers and fries to irresistible milkshakes and even signature breakfast dishes, the menu embraces diner staples.

I went with the Oasis Burger and snuck home a piece of their carrot cake for a later dessert. Ask to sniff the Devil's Food cake for yourself—yes, I said sniff. It is amazing.



Rusted Silo Southern BBQ

Yearning for that classic, down-home barbecue experience? Look no further than Rusted Silo Southern BBQ—a quintessential rusty shack nestled alongside the train tracks. With meats slow-smoked in-house and sauces crafted from scratch, this joint embodies the essence of authentic barbecue.

Their menu also boasts a delightful array of Southern-inspired sides, from mac and cheese to collard greens and even banana pudding.

Beer enthusiasts will relish the curated selection of craft brews, making this a flavorful and satisfying destination.

Brew Link Brewing

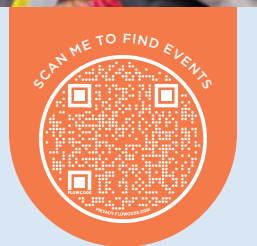


INDIANA GUITAR SHOW • SPRING SHOW: APRIL • FALL SHOW: SEPTEMBER

HENDRICKS COUNTY 4-H FAIRGROUNDS, DANVILLE

The largest musical gear event held in Indiana annually, the Indiana Guitar Show draws more than 100 national dealers of vintage and new guitars, PA systems, fiddles, dulcimers, recording equipment, amps, vinyl records and much more available for buy, sell and trade.

The two-day event is held in the spring and fall at the Hendricks County 4-H Fairgrounds and Conference Complex in Danville.



INDIANA FISHING EXPO FIRST WEEKEND IN FEBRUARY

HENDRICKS COUNTY 4-H FAIRGROUNDS, DANVILLE

The ultimate gathering for any angler as nearly 100 vendors and expert speakers gather annually for this two-day event that is the most species-diverse fishing show in the region.



MAPLE SYRUP DAYS FIRST TWO SATURDAYS IN MARCH

MCCLOUD NATURE PARK, NORTH SALEM

Ever wondered how maple syrup makes it from tree to table to tummy? At this event, held annually during the first two Saturdays in March, you'll see the entire process, from sap collection to pancake partnership; you can even tap a tree yourself! You can also learn how to identify trees in the winter and how Native Americans first made maple syrup.

HENDRICKS COUNTY RIB-FEST & BBQ

LAST SATURDAY IN JUNE • HENDRICKS COUNTY 4-H FAIRGROUNDS, DANVILLE

One of the best events of the summer in central Indiana occurs the last Saturday in June, when the Hendricks County Rib-Fest & BBQ takes over the Hendricks County 4-H Fairgrounds.

The event features music, not-for-profit vendor booths and lots of delicious food and drink. After dark comes a festive illumination of hot air balloons and fireworks.

The fun kicks off with the Rib-Run 5k in the morning and ends with fireworks in the evening. Don't forget to bring your blankets and chairs!

NASCAR CRAFTSMAN TRUCK SERIES

TSport 200 • JULY

Continuing a tradition which dates back to 1982, NASCAR returns to Lucas Oil Indianapolis Raceway Park. The NASCAR CRAFTSMAN Truck Series TSport 200 races under the lights as future stars of stock car racing compete on the historic paved oval.

NHRA U.S. NATIONALS

THURSDAY-MONDAY OF LABOR DAY WEEKEND

Like your car races short, fast and LOUD? Since 1961, Brownsburg has hosted the granddaddy of them all.

The largest and most prestigious event in drag racing draws professional and sport racers from across North America. It's the final race of the NHRA's regular season and sets the 10-driver field in each class for the six-race Countdown to the Championship.



DESTINATION DANVILLE

FIRST SATURDAY IN JUNE
HENDRICKS COUNTY COURTHOUSE SQUARE, DANVILLE

This central Indiana festival held on the square in Danville for makers by makers is a juried event with limited categories creating a wider variety of product options as well as food vendors and even local breweries and distilleries.



INDY TATTOO EXPO

JUNE • HENDRICKS COUNTY 4-H FAIRGROUNDS, DANVILLE

A three-day gathering where more than 150 top tattoo artists across the country show off their artistic talents occurs every year in Hendricks County. The event includes tattoo appointments, live entertainment and various vendors.



HENDRICKS COUNTY 4-H FAIR

JUNE • HENDRICKS COUNTY 4-H FAIRGROUNDS, DANVILLE

Boasting one of the best fairground facilities in central Indiana, the Hendricks County 4-H Fair provides everything you expect and more from a county fair.

Free shows, amazing fair food, farm animals on display, carnival rides and top-notch entertainment including the annual demolition derby make it a summer tradition that shouldn't be missed.

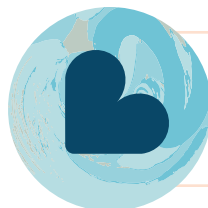

ARBUCKLE ACRES TRAIL • BROWNSBURG

This paved trail in Arbuckle Acres Park, 200 N. Green St., provides hikers with an easy stroll through a 16-acre parcel of woods. The trail parallels White Lick Creek for a good distance before climbing uphill to a bend in the trail. The elevated bridge to cross the creek provides great views of the creek and lower area.

Length: Nearly a mile • *Difficulty:* Easy to moderate

AVON TOWN HALL PARK TRAIL • AVON

Featuring a 10-foot-wide paved trail that loops through Town Hall Park, 6570 E. U.S. 36, this trail offers a diverse mix of scenic and environmental views. Some of the highlights include a 9-acre lake, open space, woods and native Indiana prairie and wetlands. The trail is handicap-accessible and fun for all age groups and skill levels.

Length: 1.5 mile • *Difficulty:* Easy

B&O TRAIL • BROWNSBURG

The former railroad turned paved trail provides an easy hiking or biking experience. More than 8 miles of paved trail currently extends through Hendricks County from the county line at Raceway Road West to County Road 250 East, west of Brownsburg. Parking can be found at multiple locations along the trail including at two trailheads where the trail crosses Green Street and where it crosses County Road 500 East. The trail eventually will extend 16 miles through Hendricks County.

Length: Nearly 9 miles • *Difficulty:* Easy

BEAVER RIDGE TRAIL • ECHO HOLLOW NATURE PARK, PLAINFIELD

This scenic trail offers hikers amazing views of a pristine wildlife refuge. The trail meanders through mature woodlands, providing views of a 5.5-acre pond below. The trail is flat, making it a favorite for trail hikers with limited mobility and has benches periodically to rest and relax.

Length: 0.6 mile • *Difficulty:* Easy

BLANTON WOODS • DANVILLE

This scenic path provides opportunities for both inexperienced and experienced hikers. This trail, 625 N. Washington St., boasts views of White Lick Creek and wildlife. Follow any of several trails to experience creek crossings, hill climbs, bird-watching podiums, bat houses, wildflowers and more.

Length: More than 4 miles • *Difficulty:* Moderate

BLUE & RED TRAILS • BURNETT WOODS NATURE PRESERVE, AVON

This secluded preserve boasts two looped trails through a heavily wooded area, providing scenic views and all the wonder of Indiana nature, including various tree and wildflower species and wildlife.

Length: 1.5 miles • *Difficulty:* Easy

BLUEBIRD TRAIL • AVON

Washington Township Park, 115 S. County Road 575 East, is home to numerous trails ranging in difficulty. However, the Bluebird Trail comes highly recommended due to its picturesque, leisurely stroll through the woods. This trail also provides easy access to some intermediate trails and the historic Iron Whipple Truss bridge built circa 1876.

Length: 0.13 miles • *Difficulty:* Easy



Plainfield Trail System

MAPLE RIDGE TRAIL • WILLIAMS PARK, BROWNSBURG

The main section of this crushed stone trail in Williams Park, 940 S. Locust Lane, isn't rigorous though several secondary trails connected to it offer more of a challenge. The natural trails sit on 45 acres and provide a nice hike with elevation changes and ravines that lead to White Lick Creek.

Length: 2-3 miles including secondary trails • *Difficulty:* Moderate

RED-TAILED RIDGE TRAIL • MCCLOUD NATURE PARK, NORTH SALEM

This trail offers hikers spectacular views as it passes over the centerpiece of McCloud Nature Park, its 100-year-old historic iron truss bridge over Big Walnut Creek. It then traverses mature woodlands and crosses through grasslands and prairies.

Length: 1.1 miles • *Difficulty:* Moderate

VANDALIA TRAIL • AMO & COATESVILLE

In a sense, Hendricks County has two trails in one along the former Vandalia Railroad, as the two sections do not actually link. A more newly paved portion of the Vandalia Trail extends from Amo to Coatesville. This portion tends to be popular for horseback riding, far away from the hustle and bustle of city life.

Length: About 3 miles • *Difficulty:* Easy to moderate

VANDALIA TRAIL • PLAINFIELD

Running from County Road 500 South to a trailhead at County Road 900 South, the paved Plainfield section has some nice spots, especially when it crosses White Lick Creek at Franklin Park, but it also runs behind subdivisions and businesses and crosses several busy streets.

Length: About 2 miles • *Difficulty:* Easy to moderate

WHITE LICK CREEK TRAIL • PLAINFIELD

Beginning at the Richard A. Carlucci Recreation & Aquatic Center, 651 Vestal Road, the White Lick Creek Trail is the centerpiece of Plainfield's trails system. This paved trail meanders south along White Lick Creek down to Hummel Park. At Friendship Gardens Park, the trail crosses over White Lick Creek on an old iron truss bridge that was relocated from southern Guilford Township.

Length: 6 miles or more • *Difficulty:* Easy to moderate

Do you love that rev of the engines, the smell of gasoline or nitromethane fuel and the heart-pounding action that comes with it? Lucas Oil Indianapolis Raceway Park features a variety of events on both its oval and 1/4-mile dragstrip every summer. It's a special place! Find out why.



Lucas Oil Indianapolis Raceway Park has become one of the signature attractions in Hendricks County and really all central Indiana, drawing the most visitors to our destination annually with its epic events on both the oval and drag strip.

What makes this place so magical? Why has it become a bucket-list attraction for so many? Buckle that seat belt and get ready to go on a tour to answer those questions.

U.S. Nationals

Any discussion about Lucas Oil Indianapolis Raceway Park must begin with the track's signature event that occurs annually over Labor Day Weekend. Known as the Big Go, U.S. Nationals remains the most prestigious drag racing event in the country.

It is the one every driver wants to win, and the one every fan wants to experience at least once in their lifetime. Five days of non-stop drag racing, where a ticket is also a pit pass, gives fans virtually unlimited access to the cars and drivers.

But it is more than that. Part of it is its legendary history to the generations of drivers and fans who revere its unmistakable allure and part of it is the indescribable experience that can't be put into words or even pictures. It is something that simply must be experienced.

Pure Fandom

Whether it's meeting your favorite driver, getting autographs or simply dreaming about racing on that track some day, race fans are diehards. And those who love it always leave Lucas Oil Indianapolis Raceway Park with memories that last their lifetime.

Typically, you either love racing, or you don't get it. Some middle ground does exist, but not much. Often, you really don't know which camp you fall into until you go and experience it for yourself.

Famed Drag Strip

I've already discussed U.S. Nationals, which is the biggest event held each year on Lucas Oil Indianapolis Raceway Park's drag strip, but it is far from the only event held there.

The track hosts Wild Wednesdays all season long, giving the average Joe an opportunity to race his car on the same drag strip the professionals have battled on for years. The strip also hosts many other drag racing events each year including the Ultimate Callout Challenge.



Paved Oval

This short-track oval has seen its share of legendary racers and amazing events as well. Just some of the names who have competed on its surface include A.J. Foyt, Jeff Gordon and Helio Castroneves.

The best part about this track is no matter where you sit, you can see all the action as cars beat and bang all the way to the checkered flag. It also hosts a variety of races including Carb Night Classic, Hoosier Hundred and the NASCAR CRAFTSMAN Truck Series TSport200.

Other Events

While racing and motorsports dominate the events that occur at Lucas Oil Indianapolis Raceway Park, it does host its share of other fun events including Cleetus and Cars, Slamology Music Festival & Automotive Show and other annual meetings, concerts and festivals.

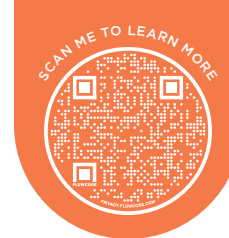

What do Hendricks County and fans of the iconic British Sci-Fi TV show *Doctor Who* (BBC One, 1963-89; 2005-present) have in common? Quite a bit, it turns out, because of the vision of one Camby man.

In 1998, Hoosier and *Doctor Who* superfan Keith Bradbury set out to provide stateside fans of the long-running series a resource for reasonably priced merchandise. 24 years later, his brainchild, Who North America in Camby, Indiana, owns the distinction of being the only *Doctor Who* store & museum in North America.

It's become a bucket-list destination for any self-respecting Whovian (what fans of the show call themselves) on the continent. One recent visitor came all the way from Hawaii—a granted birthday wish for a die-hard fan.

There's a lot to see when you step into Who North America. Like, A LOT. To help keep you from being overwhelmed, here are a couple highlights:

TARDIS

Upon entering, the first thing you'll likely see is the TARDIS (a time machine from the series that looks like a British police box and whose name is an acronym for *Time and Relative Dimension In Space*) greeting you at the front door. It's become one of the top photo spots in Hendricks County. Don't leave Who North America without getting a selfie next to the TARDIS.

Game Room

Somewhat hidden between the museum and retail areas and behind the checkout area, you'll find a *Doctor Who* full-size pinball machine and *Star Trek: Voyager* arcade game for two players. Both are free to play.

Merchandise

If you're a true fan, you'll think you've gone to *Doctor Who* heaven. Literally thousands of items can be found on the retail side of Who North America, including (but certainly not limited to): action figures, masks, games, clothing, books and virtually any other *Doctor Who*-related item imaginable. They even have sweets from the UK, including Jelly Babies and Jammie Dodgers.
