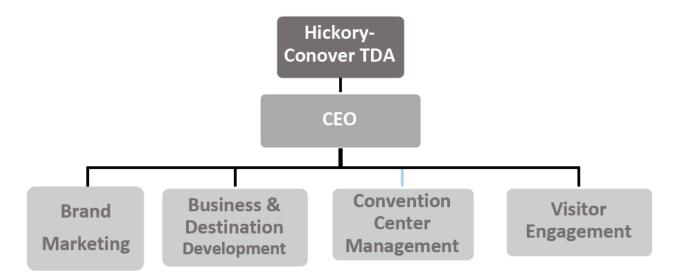
Organization Structure
