

More than 150 miles of bike trails spool out around the greater Holland area, making this Lake Michigan beachtown an ideal hub for cycling. Looped routes link popular destinations like Tunnel Park, Windmill Island, and Kollen Park. Other scenic routes include the 11-mile wooded tract to Saugatuck and the 20- mile Lakeshore Connector Path to Grand Haven. For a longer ride, choose from two 40-mile loops starting downtown or join the 500-mile US Bike Route 35 that runs through Holland and continues all the way to Canada.

Looking for ideas on where to begin your bike adventure? Where to rent a bike? Where to fix or fine-tune your ride? All the details on staging areas, route maps, and rental and repair facilities are in the pages that follow.

SAFETY FIRST

Bicyclists have the same rights and responsibilities as the driver of any other motor vehicle and can be ticketed for violating Michigan traffic laws. Holland offers a variety of riding trails, share the road riding, dedicated bike lanes, and multi-use paths. Bicyclists may "claim the lane," but are not to ride more than two abreast in the travel lane.



Sidewalk riding is legal in the Holland area with the exception of downtown, where signs are posted. Look for Wheel Control Zone signs prohibiting bicycling, roller blading, and skateboarding.





Mileage to Holland (approximate)

Saugatuck 12 miles 19 Kilometers **Grand Haven** 21 miles 38 Kilometers U.S. Bicycle Route 35 is a 500-mile route that runs from Indiana through Michigan to Sault Ste. Marie, Canada, generally following the Lake Michigan shoreline and then continuing through the eastern Upper Peninsula. It is part of the United States Bicycle Route System (USBRS), a national cycling route network. It consists of intrastate long-distance cycling routes that use multiple types of bicycling infrastructure, including offroad paths, bicycle lanes, and low-traffic roads.

Mountain Biking

Bass River Recreation Area

Three distinct loops suitable for all levels of riders. Mostly flat, packed dirt terrain with a couple short, small climbs. Lots of tight, twisting sections with close proximity to trees with some sections becoming sandy. Portions of the trail can become quite muddy when it rains. Fun trail for beginners to experts. Gravel roads and two tracks surrounding the mountain bike portion of the trails. Recreation Passport required. 13800 104th Ave, Grand Haven, MI 49417

Pigeon Creek County Park

Relatively easy mix of scenic trails. Some areas potentially loose on the surface - proceed with caution. North side trail is flat, fairly straight, and good for sticking the bike in the "big ring." The main trails south of Stanton Street have easy turns and generally easy grades with beautiful spots along the river. 12524 Stanton St., West Olive, MI 49460

Riley Trails

Multi-use trail boasting a one-way 4.5 mile mountain bike loop with mostly flat terrain. Trails suitable for all skill levels and include wooded areas with pines and hardwoods, meadows, marshes, and bridge crossing. Ideal trail following inclement weather – fast draining sandier soil makes this a destination trail when others are closed. Open to cyclists and hikers yearround, closed to hunters.

Shore Acres Bike Park

A 1.5 mile singletrack adjacent to Felt Mansion in Laketown Township. Designed for intermediate to advanced users, trail has short, challenging climbs and downhill sections. Trailhead and kiosk located at southwest corner of parking lot at Shore Acres Township Park. The trail is directional and clearly marked. Neighboring Saugatuck Dunes State Park is closed to cycling; observe trail signs.

Upper Macatawa Natural Area

Singletrack trail winds through forested ravines along Macatawa River. Trails can be very challenging, beginners are advised to use caution. Mixed clay surface fails to hold up well after heavy rains; the trail is closed during those times. Please obey signs on trails marked "hiking only."


