### DeVOS FIELD HOUSE

A \$22 million, 102,000 square-foot facility with seating for 3,400, DeVos features two basketball courts, state-of-the-art weight room, a ticket office and two concessions stands. Owned and operated by Hope College, the DeVos has played host to the NCAA DIII Women's Final IV Basketball and Volleyball Championships as well as a variety of MHSAA and NCAA tournaments.

### DOW CENTER

This on-campus facility features an olympic size pool, diving well,  $\frac{1}{10}$  mile indoor track, 3 racquetball courts, 3 Wally ball courts, 3 indoor basketball/volleyball courts, locker rooms, 2 dry saunas, weight room, cardio room.

### VAN ANDEL SOCCER STADIUM

Open in 2009, Van Anel Soccer Stadium accommodates an estimated 1,400 fans in stadium-style and bleacher seating with accompanying terrace areas for picnicking and tailgating. There is a first aid/training room, two full locker rooms, a meeting room for visiting teams, ticket booth and a press box, concession stand and public restrooms. The field surface is artificial turf and there is stadium lighting for night games.

Hope's football stadium offers seating for over 5,300 fans, plus several hundred more in the end zone hillside. The stadium features new artificial turf, a spacious press box, two concession stands and restrooms.

Beautiful baseball and softball facilities were added to the Buys Athletics Complex in 2008. The project included the installation of permanent stands seating up to 400, a new press box and dugouts. Fans have an unobstructed view of the playing fields. The area also has a patio suitable for tailgating.

### ETHERIDGE TENNIS COMPLEX

A six-court, 40,000 square-foot indoor tennis center was named the "Facility of the Year" in 2010 by the Professional Tennis Registry. The adjacent, newly opened Vande Poel-Heeringa Stadium Courts include 12 outdoor courts with elevated seating for spectators and an officials' shelter.

The Holland Aquatic Center is a state of the art facility that has hosted competitive swim meets from local and state meets, to national championships at all levels (including the NCAA DIII Men's and Women's Championships).

The Aquatic Center features two 1-meter and two 3-meter diving boards, an 8-lane, 50-meter competitive pool with a movable bulkhead that allows it to be configured in a variety of ways, as well as a 25-yard, 6-lane warm-up pool and diving well. The facility also boasts the Colorado Time System and Scoreboard. The spectator area features a permanent elevated bleacher area with seating capacity for 600 (plus additional on-deck seating).
