Bowl of Cream

A multi-award winner, this cultivar produces large, full-bodied creamy white flowers with a slight fragrance. It's robust and reliable, and the blossoms can reach up to 8-12" across! A late bloomer.

Festiva Maxima

An old favorite, Festiva Maxima boasts large, fluffy white flowers with occasional crimson flecks at the heart of the bloom. The plant is highly fragrant and extremely coldhardy, a perfect fit for Alaska's cool summer climate.

Flower size up to 9". Mid-season bloomer.

Duchess de Nemours:

This elegant variety produces large, pure white, globeshaped flowers with a luminous yellow glow at the base of the petals. Duchess de Nemours is known for its sweet fragrance and is a long-lasting variety, ideal for cut flowers. Flower size 4-5". The earliest white bloomer.

Red Charm

An early-blooming peony, Red Charm has rich, red, double flowers with a glossy sheen. Its strong stems and exquisite blooms make it a favorite for gardens and floral arrangements. Flower size 6". Early season bloomer.

Kansas

Kansas peonies are an award-winning variety that features double, vibrant, deep pink flowers. They are highly prized for their durability, sweet fragrance, and long vase life. Flower size 8-9". Mid-season bloomer.

Coral Sunset

Known for its stunning, large, semi-double blossoms in shades of coral and peach, Coral Sunset is an early-season bloomer. Its flowers fade to a softer peachy-pink as they age, adding depth and interest to the plant over time. Flower size 6". Early season bloomer.

Sarah Bernhardt

Named after the famous French actress, this variety is one of the most popular of all peonies. It offers large, double, pale pink flowers with a powerful fragrance. Sarah Bernhardt is late-blooming and grows well in Alaska's cooler summers. Flower size 6-7". Late season bloomer.

Remember, Alaska's unique summer daylight hours encourage a slower bud development, allowing Alaskan peonies to be exceptionally large and vibrant.
