The vendor fee for this 2-day event is \$300 for Homer Chamber Members, and \$350 for non-Chamber Members. Fee includes electrical & water hookups. Non-Profit groups not using utility hookups are \$150 for the two days. Make checks payable to the Homer Chamber of Commerce.
In the event that water is not available, a \$50 refund will be issued.

- We will be setting the trucks up in the KOA camping sites that are located along the Sterling Highway. These sites do have electrical hookups at each site. Water may also be available if the ground thaws enough to have water flowing by that time.

(OVER)

- All booths must remain open during the **Taste of Homer Festival**. Failure to remain open for the duration of the **TOH** will result in possible exclusion from participation in any future **Homer Chamber of Commerce and Visitor Center event**.
- Vendors are responsible for their own property. HCOC organizers, volunteers, or staff are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Vendors **MUST** leave the site in the same condition as before the event. Spilled oil or any cleanup will be charged a minimum \$50/hr clean up fee. Broken pedestals or sewer cap replacements will be charged \$50/hr labor plus materials.
- Vendors are responsible for removing their garbage. A giant garbage bin will be provided on-site by Moore & Moore Services.
- The use of biodegradable/compostable service ware is preferred.
- All food vendors are required to obtain an AK DEC Temporary Food Permit, a Food Truck Permit from the City of Homer, be set up to collect and pay sales tax to the Kenai Borough, and have Personal Liability Insurance listing the Homer Chamber of Commerce as additional insured. Please attach a copy of each with the application and have a copy available at your booth the day of the event. The DEC may be on-site to check each booth during the tournament.
- Public activities such as Food Vendors and Beer Garden, could be cancelled if Festival organizers or local healthcare officials determine those activities are not in the best public interest due to health related concerns.
