- Meeting called to order-8:39am
- Guest Speaker: Pam Reese-Community Liaison
  - Welcome to Robinson Nature Center-LEED Platinum facility
  - Lots of events coming up with master gardeners
- Tony thanks the board for their hard work. Official announcement that he's leaving VHC.
- Previous meeting minutes (vote)
  - Votes to approve-unanimous
- Financials (vote)
  - Overall health of the hotels right now--down a few % points
  - Howard County is doing well in this downswing-over the other counties in the state
  - Baltimore and DC are both struggling to fill their convention calendars and that bleeds into our market
  - AirBnb is taking a large market share with no taxes owed
  - Federal events are not taking place with the same schedule as before, because there is no one in the government to approve these events
  - There are threats and downward pressure on us as a result of these trends
  - Overall revenue will be down for the next year, we're looking at a hit to the budget
    - MD State grant is also a flexible number, and we cannot know yet what we'll be granted from that office
  - Vote to move the savings fund from a high risk account to a more approachable account
  - Why is marketing looking down now? Because we haven't actually spent the money yet
  - Why is there so much money allocated under the website fee? Because of the contract with Simpleview, the invoices come in together, and we need to break out what is not billed under the website fees. We need to get a new website that has less of a maintenance fee.
  - P. Mangione-we're on track for the year, Pete would like to get rolling on the budget for next year--coming up at the Executive Committee meeting next week
  - Votes to approve the financials-unanimous
- Review Membership Fee (vote)
  - Membership is behind FY17 by 12 or so members, that's because some of the free memberships we gave out after the EC flood did not renew for an additional year
  - Has there been discussion amongst the staff about changing the structure for next year?
    - If we increase the price, we may be able to bring in the same amount of money, but many will drop off and no longer participate
    - M. Clark--it doesn't make sense to keep changing the price, because it's about engagement, not about revenue generation
    - A. Troglio-many of her merchants would likely leave if we doubled the price
    - E. Ebersole-do you know who you'd lose first?-Restaurants, retail & Attractions
    - D. Balderson-have you created tiers of membership for those businesses that want enhanced benefits?
      - Yes, there is a structure in place for different levels of benefits--we can look at creating some more intermittent levels
  - Vote to approve to maintain \$50 membership fees-unanimous
