For over 7 decades, Huntsville has played a major role in NASA's mission to explore space. In honor of all that this community has done to support the Space Launch System (Artemis) vehicle, we have hidden 1-foot tall rockets around the downtown area for you to find.


The general locations are listed on the back, but you'll have to do the work to find where the rockets are hidden. Bring your family, friends, and coworkers if they are up for the challenge.

### DID YOU KNOW?

The Artemis II test flight will be NASA's first mission with crew aboard the SLS rocket and Orion spacecraft. The four astronauts will orbit the Moon to verify that all spacecraft systems function as intended with a crew aboard in the actual deep-space environment.
