We are pleased to announce a **Special Research Stream** to be held as part of the **ICCA Congress 2026 in Panama City, Panama**.

The convention and business events sector is undergoing a profound transformation. Pressures related to sustainability, destination carrying capacity, labour conditions, digital platform power, geopolitical fragmentation, and changing professional expectations are challenging long-standing assumptions about growth, value creation, and legacy in convention tourism and events.

Who should participate in the special Research Stream?

This research stream provides a dedicated forum for **academics, students and industry-engaged researchers** to exchange, share, and critically examine emerging perspectives on convention tourism and events. The goal is to stimulate dialogue, challenge dominant narratives, and develop new theoretical, empirical, and methodological insights that are relevant to both academia and the global association meetings community. Therefore, collaborative papers of academics and industry practitioners are encouraged.

- All accepted full papers will undergo a **rigorous double-blind peer-review process**.
- **Best papers will be formally acknowledged** during the ICCA Congress 2026.
- Selected papers will be **invited for publication** in a **special edition of the *Journal of Convention and Event Tourism*** (see <https://www.tandfonline.com/journals/wcet20/about-this-journal#aims-and-scope>), subject to the journal's review requirements.

Topics of interest for the Research Stream

The Research Stream Chair welcomes abstracts on the following topics (but not limited to):

- Event fatigue among residents and repeat attendees
- Over-eventisation and diminishing marginal returns of recurring conventions
- Destination carrying capacity, crowding, and quality of life
- Political economy of convention bidding and hosting (co-opetition, power relations, subsidies, public finance, lobbying)
- Deglobalisation and the regionalisation of business events
- Intellectual, professional, and knowledge legacies of conventions
- Informal, pop-up, and unbranded events (anti-conference and unconference formats)
- The dark (human) side of event tourism (labour precarity, volunteer burnout, harassment, safety, power abuse)
- Artificial intelligence in events: algorithmic gatekeeping, platform power, and bias
- Post-growth and degrowth perspectives in event tourism
- Intergenerational dynamics in convention and event attendance
- Academic–industry partnerships in convention and event tourism

Abstract length: Maximum 400 words
- Accepted abstracts will be invited to submit full papers (extended abstract of either 1000 or 2000 words) **by 31 July 2026**.
- Full papers and abstracts will undergo a double-blind peer-review process
- Reviewer feedback expected: **31 August 2026**
- Final corrected paper submission: **30 September 2026**

- Abstracts must not exceed **400 words**.
- Abstracts should clearly outline the purpose, methodology, and contribution of the proposed paper.
- Formats: Full papers, research notes, poster presentations
