## SCUBA DIVING

*Logansport (3)*

Enjoy the serenity of scuba diving at France Park in Logansport. This unique underwater adventure in a former quarry features sunken vehicles and boats turned into artificial reefs, freshwater fish, rock formations, quarry walls, old relics, and many hidden surprises.

## FAIR OAKS FARMS

*Fair Oaks*

## TURKEY RUN STATE PARK

## MADISON, INDIANA


*Madison (11)*

## BIRCK BOILERMAKER GOLF COMPLEX: PETE DYE CLUBHOUSE

The highly esteemed Birck Boilermaker Golf Complex is set to undergo an upgrade with the addition of the Pete Dye Clubhouse. It is poised to redefine not only the golfing experience in **West Lafayette** but also the broader narrative of Purdue University's athletic legacy.



## WELLFIELD BOTANIC GARDEN EXPANSION

After two years of construction, Wellfield Botanic Gardens will open its new Events and Visitors Center Expansion to the public Saturday, April, 5 in **Elkhart**. This project represents one of the final phases of their master plan and features a new 12,000-square-foot visitor center, the new Woodland Pavilion, enhanced parking, and the relocation of the Cottage.



## INDIANA RAIL EXPERIENCE

They make their fudge with real butter and cream and is made on-site daily. They also offer homemade ice cream and chocolates, taffy, Uranus sodas, and whimsical merchandise.



## LARRY BIRD MUSEUM

Step into the world of one of basketball's greatest icons and immerse yourself in the legacy of Larry Bird in **Terre Haute**. Explore rare memorabilia, iconic jerseys, interactive exhibits, as well as never-before-seen interviews throughout Larry Bird's unparalleled career.



## MONON SOUTH TRAIL

The Monon South Trail is a proposed 57-mile trail between Mitchell and the **Clark/Floyd County** border that connects eight local communities in the Lawrence, Orange, Washington, and Clark Counties uplands region of southern Indiana. The greenway trail offers dramatic vistas of the Indiana farmland and linkages to several regional natural destinations.



## LINCOLN AMPHITHEATRE EXPANSION

The Lincoln Amphitheater has undergone a transformation ahead of its 2025 summer season. At the heart of it are 700 additional seats that will allow even more people to enjoy unique summer experiences and more diverse entertainment options near **Lincoln City**. 2025 introduces the new Patio 1816 and Patio 1830, which are covered seating options providing a more social experience.
