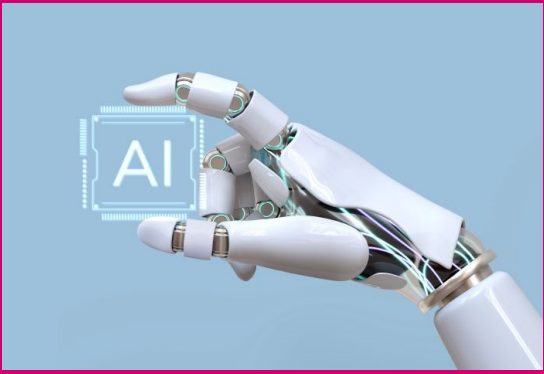

The University of Salford are a part of £1 million project to develop new heat pump technology.

The Energy House Labs team at Salford will collaborate with Bristol-based start-up, Nusku, which has raised almost £1 million of investment, including a grant of more than £700,000 from the Government.

Later this year Nusku will test their innovative product at the University of Salford's Energy House 1 test facility, a specially built Victorian terraced house in a climate-controlled chamber. The controlled environment will allow testing to be done in months that may otherwise take years.

Manchester has the oldest public library in Britain...

Established in 1653 Chetham's Library has been in continuous use as a public library for over 350 years. The library holds over 100,000 texts accumulated across its centuries in operation, with over 60,00 of the library's titles dating back to the 1800s. Located opposite the National Football Museum, entry to the library is through the main gate on Long Millgate, just off Cathedral Gardens.
